

AN ORDINANCE **47635**

ORDERING THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 2ND DAY OF APRIL, 1977, IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS, FOR THE ELECTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. That the regular municipal election be, and the same is ordered hereby to be held on Saturday, the 2nd day of April, A.D., 1977, in accordance with the laws of Texas and the provisions of the Charter of the City of San Antonio, for the election of the following municipal officers, to-wit:

Ten Members of the Council, Place 1 through Place 10, being one each to be elected from districts or wards numbered accordingly (all as provided by Section 4 of the City Charter), each for a term of two years beginning on the first day of May, 1977; and One Member to be elected as Mayor, Place 11, by a majority of all qualified voters voting in said election as provided in Section 4 and 9 of the City Charter.

SECTION 2. Said election shall be held as prescribed by law, in the City of San Antonio at the following polling or voting places in the several precincts of the City of San Antonio between the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock P.M.:

SECTION 3. Voting at said election shall be done by the use of voting machines, paper ballots or the electronic voting system as determined by the City Clerk, and the City Council of the City of San Antonio does determine hereby that voting machines, paper ballots or electronic voting system shall be used for the casting of absentee votes at this election, and a voting machine shall be placed in the office of the City Clerk, in the City Hall of San Antonio, Texas; and the City Clerk, or any Assistant City Clerk, is authorized and charged to perform the functions provided by law in the casting of absentee ballots and shall hold such election, and ballots shall be cast commencing March 14, 1977, and ending March 29, 1977; all in the method, manner and time made and provided by the Statutes of the State of Texas on this subject.

SECTION 4. The Mayor shall appoint the election officers to hold said election, in accordance with law, including a special canvassing board which shall count and canvass the absentee ballots cast at said election.

SECTION 5. Notice of said election shall be given by publishing a substantial copy of this Ordinance in a daily newspaper of general circulation published in the City, not less than 30 days before the date of the election.

SECCION 1.
