

AN ORDINANCE

APPROVING AND ADOPTING VOTING PRE-
CINCTS FOR THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO,
AND PRESCRIBING DUTIES OF THE CITY
CLERK.



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the entire area embraced within Bexar County voting precincts Numbers 13, 14, 32, 84, 96, 97, 105, 106, 129, 130, 136, 137, 139, 140, 141, 142, 143, 144, 145 and 146, having been annexed to and become a part of the City of San Antonio, the numbers and boundaries of said precincts as heretofore lawfully designated and established by the Commissioners Court of Bexar County, Texas, are hereby approved and adopted as voting precincts of the City of San Antonio; and parts of the area embraced within Bexar County voting precincts numbers 67, 138, 158, 159, 167, ~~168~~, 169 and 197 having been annexed to and become a part of the City of San Antonio, the numbers and boundary lines of said precincts as heretofore lawfully designated and established by said Commissioners Court of Bexar County, Texas, insofar as said boundary lines relate and pertain to the parts of said precincts now within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, are hereby approved and adopted as voting precincts of the City of San Antonio. The numbers and boundary lines of all of said precincts are shown by the County records, and the parts of said precincts 67, 138, 158, 159, 167, ~~168~~ 169 and 197 which have been annexed are shown by the annexation ordinances of the City and the maps made in connection therewith.


2. The City Clerk is authorized and directed to make and deliver to the presiding judges of election in the various precincts and parts of precincts aforesaid, certified lists showing the names and addresses of all persons who reside within said precincts and parts of precincts, who have paid their State and County poll taxes and have been issued receipts therefor, or who have been issued certificates of exemption; and containing such other information as may be required by the State laws governing elections.
