77R-206 AN ORDINANCE (1982)

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE ON EXPERIMENTAL FARM.
