AN ORDINANCE **5 618 2**

REVISING AND ESTABLISHING CITY VOTING  
PRECINCTS EFFECTIVE March 1, 1983  
CONFORMING TO CITY ANNEXATION PURSUANT  
TO SECTION 4 OF THE CITY CHARTER.

WHEREAS, the City Council of San Antonio passed and approved on the 5th day of August, 1982 Ordinance 55655 establishing new districts boundaries, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of San Antonio adopted a redistricting plan described as Revised Plan B in accordance with provisions of Section 4 of the City Charter of the City of San Antonio, and

WHEREAS, voting precincts located within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio for the General Election of April 2, 1983, shall be the identical precincts so located as revised, established and corrected by the Commissioners Court of Bexar County, State of Texas, as promulgated by its orders on March 22, 1982, and the 30th day of August, 1982 as fully and to all intents and purposes as if they were compiled herein. Said voting precincts being numbered as follows:

SUBJECT: Ordinance Establishing Precincts

Date November 12, 1982

Summary

State Law requires that voting precincts be established by the City Council. The precincts are actually established by Bexar County Commissioners' Court and the City adopts them by reference.

Background

This is necessary and routine preliminary to the April 2, 1983 City Election.

The Bexar County Commissioner's Court has approved several minor numbering and boundary changes to the new voting precincts within the City. These have occurred since the Department of Justice approved the new City Council Districts for the April 1983 election. The Districts that have experienced precinct changes are: four, five and ten. The changes have not altered the approved total population of the Council Districts; however three districts have changes in the population of the new voting precincts.

District 4

Precinct 1024 has been omitted and precinct 1022 occupies the entire area.

District 5

Precinct 2002 has been split to create precinct 2002 in the northern half and the new precinct 2070 in the southern part.

Precinct 2008 has also been split leaving precinct 2008 in the northern half and placing new precinct 2071 in the southern section.

District 10

Precinct 3090 has been redrawn to follow FM 1604 to Classen Road, then it follows Jones Maltsberger to Thousand Oaks. The eastern portion of this precinct is outside the city limits.

District 10 (Continued)


Precinct 3083 has been expanded to have Thousand Oaks as its northern boundary.

Precinct 3088 has been revised to create precinct 3103 along Nacogdoches Road.


Precinct 3103 has replaced 3088 in the vicinity of Nacogdoches Road.
