

AN ORDINANCE 2010-06-24-0636

APPOINTING CLARISSA L. CHAVARRIA AS A MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE FOR THE REMAINDER OF AN UNEXPIRED TERM TO EXPIRE APRIL 30, 2012

* * * * *

WHEREAS, the Municipal Court Advisory Committee is charged, by Ordinance No. 2007-05-31-0595, with providing recommendations for judicial appointments to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Committee has conducted a thorough review of judicial candidates in order to fill a Municipal Court Judge vacancy for the juvenile docket; and

WHEREAS, after interviewing five of the fifteen qualified candidates, the Committee members have unanimously recommended Clarissa L. Chavarria to fill this vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City to approve the recommendation of the Committee; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council approves the recommendation of the Municipal Court Advisory Committee to appoint Clarissa L. Chavarria as a Municipal Court Judge for the remainder of a two-year term effective August 1, 2010, to expire April 30, 2012, with an annual salary of \$95,512.04 and the same benefits currently extended to full-time San Antonio Municipal Court Judges.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$19,102.41 for this Ordinance is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 301010001, as part of the Fiscal Year 2010 Budget as set out in the table below:

SECTION 3. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer (CFO), City of San Antonio. The CFO may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.




