## ----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

Communication from H.T. Rand proposing to build concrete retaining wall along east bank of San Antonio River, between Houston and Travis Streets, under certain conditions, was read and referred to Commissioner of Sanitation, Parks and Public Buildings.

Bid of Alamo Iron Works for installing gasoline filling station for City was referred to Purchasing Agent.

G.H & S.A. Railway Company, for permit to build additional spur in Mesquite Street was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements.

No. 271 AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$16.40 to pay for brief in case of City of San Antonio vs. Trinity Methodist Church, on appeal to Court of Civil Appeals.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Sixteen and 40/100 (\$16.40) Dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of the Judgement Fund to pay W.C. Williams for eight copies of brief of City in cause No. 5973, City of San Antonio vs Trinity Methodist Church, on appeal to Court of Civil Appeals.




Commissioner Lowther requested permission to leave the City for a few days, which was granted.
