

AN ORDINANCE

2012-05-31-0386

RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$53,000.00 PROVIDED BY THE AID TO HELPLESS ANIMAL FUND OF THE SAN ANTONIO AREA FOUNDATION FOR ADDITIONAL SPAY/NEUTER SURGERIES FOR THE PERIOD OF JUNE 1, 2012 THROUGH MAY 31, 2013.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio is committed to increasing its live release rate as documented in the 2012 Animal Care Services (ACS) Strategic Plan; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Strategic Plan, ACS received funding in FY 2012 to increase its live release rate to 38%; and

WHEREAS, the plan anticipated reaching 70% in FY 2015, however, in the first 6 months of FY 2012, ACS averaged a rate of 59%; and

WHEREAS, also, in the last three months (February, March, April), ACS has enjoyed record-breaking rates of 68%, 66%, and 68% respectively; and

WHEREAS, although excited about this increase, ACS recognized that this success would require additional resources, for instance, as the live release rate increases ACS is expected to also see an increase in expenses associated with spay/neuter surgeries, medical supplies, and contractual personnel resources; and

WHEREAS, by accepting this grant, it is anticipated that ACS could provide the required funding for 1000 additional spay/neuter surgeries associated with adoptions/rescues of ACS animals;
NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The submission of the grant application to the Aid to Helpless Animal Fund of the San Antonio Area Foundation is hereby ratified. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the Animal Care Services Department or his designee is hereby authorized to accept grant funds in an amount up to \$53,000.00 provided by the Aid to Helpless Animal Fund of the San Antonio Area Foundation for additional spay/neuter surgeries for the period of June 1, 2012 through May 31, 2013. A copy of said application which is incorporated herein for all purposes is on file with the Animal Care Services Department.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the Animal Care Services Department or his designee is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said grant application and acceptance of funds.

SECTION 3. Fund 26012000 entitled "MISC. AGENCIES" is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant should funding be awarded. The sum of up to \$53,000.00 from the Aid to Helpless Animal Fund of the San Antonio Area Foundation will be appropriated in said fund. The proposed budget which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I** is approved. A formal final budget which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon award.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.






