

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, MAY 2nd, A.D.1921, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Heuermann, Wright. Absent, Lambert.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police: Texas Petroleum Products Co. relating to construction of oil storage tanks. Sewell Sign System, for permit to erect sign at 118 West Crockett Street. Requesting removal of hobby horse outfit from the 1100 block on River Avenue. Shiner Bros, to install gasoline pump and tank 520 Avenue C. Alf Ruh " " " " " " Roosevelt Ave and Mitchell Street.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements: To place gravel on Mississippi Street. To macadamize E. Lotus Street. To macadamize Yale Avenue. Complaining of the condition of Polaris Street.

No. 571 AN ORDINANCE *MD-1275*
Appropriating \$38.50 to pay Cal Burton for sidewalk construction.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$38.50 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1920 General Fund to pay Cal Burton for constructing sidewalk in front of Lot A-6 C.B.141, Soledad and Romana Streets, and in front of Lot 18, C.B.1659, corner Nolan and Willow Streets, as per estimate of City Engineer.

Appropriating \$168.75 to pay the Uvalde Company.
