

AN ORDINANCE **87566**

AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS IN CONNECTION WITH THE 1998 FIESTA SAN ANTONIO CELEBRATION; APPROVING THE LOCATIONS, DATES AND TIMES FOR THE FIESTA CARNIVAL, AND RELATED REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS; APPROVING THE FIESTA ROUTES; AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 85694, PASSED ON MARCH 6, 1997, TO REFLECT SUCH CHANGES.

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WHEREAS, San Antonio's annual Fiesta San Antonio Celebration, through the dedicated efforts of many civic-minded persons and nonprofit organizations, has achieved state wide, national, and international recognition as one of the outstanding festival events in our nation; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 75391 of March 5, 1992, set the dates for Fiesta San Antonio for the years 1992 through 1998, designated the Fiesta San Antonio Commission as the Planning and Coordinating organization for the event, provided for and allocated financial support to Fiesta events, adopted regulations for Fiesta events, and made other provisions in connection with Fiesta; and

WHEREAS, planning is underway for the 1998 Fiesta San Antonio, and it is necessary to approve certain events, close streets to vehicular traffic in connection with certain events, approve the dates, times and locations for events, including the Fiesta Carnival, and declaring the rules, regulations and conditions for staging these events; and also to approve the Fiesta Parade Routes and close streets to vehicular traffic in connection with the Fiesta Parades; and

WHEREAS, in planning for the 1998 Fiesta San Antonio, it has been agreed that certain portions of Ordinance No. 85694 of March 6, 1997, be amended; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The following Fiesta events are approved for the dates and times as set forth below. The listed public streets and ways shall be closed to vehicular traffic during the dates and times indicated to facilitate the events and their use of the public property.

1. **SOUTHWEST CRAFT CENTER ART FAIR**: Augusta Street from Giraud Street to Navarro Street will be made a temporary one way (eastbound). The street will be closed from 12:00 Noon Friday, April 17 until 6:00 P.M. on Sunday, April 19 to accommodate unloading and set-up of Fair exhibits and parking of service vehicles. Two off-duty police officers will be required to direct traffic on site on Friday, April 17 from 12:00 Noon until 6:00 P.M.; Saturday, April 18 from 8:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M.; and on Sunday, April 19 from 10:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M.

2. **NIGHT IN OLD SAN ANTONIO**: South Presa Street from Market Street to Nueva Street, the median and west bound lanes of Nueva Street from South Alamo Street to 100 feet west of South Presa Street; the eastbound turning lane of Nueva Street approximately 100 feet west of Alamo Street; southbound curb land of Alamo Street between Villita and Nueva Streets. The streets will be closed from Saturday, April 18 at 8:30 A.M. until Sunday, April 26 at 12:00 P.M.

3. **FIESTA DEL MERCADO**: San Saba Street from Dolorosa to West Commerce Street. During Pre-Fiesta week: the east lane will be closed for booth set-up work on Monday, April 13 beginning at 12:00 Noon until Friday, April 17 at 11:00 A.M.; the west side sidewalk will also be closed for booth set-up; one traffic lane will be open down the middle of the street; pedestrian access will be maintained on the street in front of the closed sidewalk; the east side sidewalk will remain open. During Fiesta week: the street will be closed on Friday, April 17 at 11:00 A.M. and left closed continuously through Monday, April 27. At 8:00 A.M. on Monday, April 27, the center traffic lane will open but the east side lane of San Saba Street and the west side sidewalk will remain closed for booth tear down until 12:00 Midnight. In addition, the drive/walk on the west side of Farmers Market (under IH 35) will be used for band parking during Fiesta Week. The Fiesta del Mercado committee will be responsible for barricades.

4. **ST. MARY'S OYSTER BAKE**: Marquette Street from 36th Street to Camino Santa Maria; Overhill Street from 36th Street to Camino Santa Maria; Ligustrum Street from Woodlawn to Marquette Street; Riverdale from 36th Street to Hillcrest. Streets will be closed to thru traffic on Friday, April 17 from 5:00 P.M. until 10:00 P.M. and Saturday, April 18 from 10:00 A.M. until 10:00 P.M. Camino Santa Maria from Colgate to Wake Forest (westside curb only for VIA parking, 12' foot width, from face of curb) on Friday, April 17 at 2:00 P.M. and remaining closed until 10:00 P.M., Saturday, April 18.

5. **FIESTA MISSION RUN**: East White Avenue from Mission Parkway to Padre Drive; Mission Parkway from East White to Mission Road; Mission Road from Mission Parkway to Mission Concepcion; Padre Drive from East White to Pyron Avenue; Pyron Avenue from Padre Drive to San Jose Drive. The streets will be closed on Saturday, April 18 from 8:00 A.M. until 10:00 A.M.

6. **PILGRIMAGE TO THE ALAMO**: Auditorium Circle and Alamo Plaza from East Houston Street to Crockett Street. Parkway will be restricted or prohibited on Martin Street from Jefferson Street to Navarro Street and Jefferson Street to Commerce Street. The streets will be closed on Monday, April 20 from 3:00 P.M. until 5:30 P.M.

7. **RIVER PARADE STREET PARTY**: Convent Street from Soledad Street to Augusta Street will be closed on Monday, April 20 from 12:00 Noon until 12:00 Midnight.

8. **PARADES (BATTLE OF FLOWERS AND FIESTA FLAMBEAU)**: Both parades will follow this route: assemble at E. Grayson to Broadway, south on Broadway, east on 3rd Street, south on Alamo Street, west on Commerce, north on Santa Rosa to Martin, disband on Martin. Broadway from Newell to Jones Avenue will be closed on Saturday, April 25 from 11:00 P.M. until Sunday, April 26 at 2:00 A.M. for bleacher removal.

9. **KING WILLIAM FAIR**: East Guenther from South Alamo Street to River Authority Parking Lot; King William Street from East Guenther to South St. Mary's Street; East Johnson and East Sheridan Streets from the San Antonio River to S. Alamo Street; East Sheridan from the San Antonio River to South Alamo Street; Beauregard and Turner Streets from Washington to South Alamo Street; Pancoast at Durango Street; Arsenal Street to City Street; Madison from East Guenther to St. Mary's Street; and Washington from Arsenal to Turner. The streets will be closed on Saturday, April 25 from 7:30 A.M. until 8:00 P.M. In addition, Eagleland Street from St. Mary's Street to Guenther Street will be closed on Saturday, April 25 from 7:30 A.M. until 12:00 non for parade staging.

10. **ST. LUKE'S FIESTA FINALE:** Manitou Drive from 11:00 A.M. until 11:00 P.M. on Sunday, April 26; Winlock Drive from Horizon to Callaghan will be made temporarily one-way with traffic flowing north to south.

11. **FIESTA EN LA VILLA DE SAN FERNANDO:** East lane of Main Street closed at 12:00 Midnight on Wednesday, April 22 for set-up for booths. Main Streets closed from Dolorosa to Commerce on Thursday, April 23 from 12:00 Noon until 12:00 Midnight; Friday, April 24, from 12:00 Noon until 12:00 Midnight; Saturday, April 25 from 12:00 Noon until 12:00 Midnight; Sunday, April 26 from 12:00 Noon until 10:00 P.M.

12. **LA GRAN JAMAICA:** Houston street between Frio and Medina Streets, Travis Street between Frio and Medina Streets. Streets will be closed from 12:00 Noon, Thursday, April 16 until 6:00 A.M., Sunday, April 26.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 85694 of March 6, 1997, is hereby amended so that the list of dates selected for the 1997 Fiesta San Antonio events and activities in Section 1 of said Ordinance is changed to the 1998 dates stated in Section 1 herein. Said Ordinance is further amended so that the carnival site (as provided for in Section 3) is changed. The ordinance is hereby amended to adopt a carnival location map for the 1998 carnival. A copy of the approved location is attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 3. The 1998 Carnival shall conform to the following schedule and requirements and conditions. The Fiesta Commission must enforce these regulations through its contract for the carnival concession.

A. **1998 CARNIVAL SCHEDULE:** The hours of operation are as follows:

C. The plan for placement of carnival booths, stands, and carnival rides must be received by the City Manager's Office by Monday, April 6, 1998. The plan must have approval of the Police Department. The Police shall be provided Police Command Posts at the carnival location as requested by the Police Department.

D. The Carnival Concessionaire shall provide sight triangles at street intersections which are not closed to traffic according to City standards.

E. The Carnival Concessionaire shall erect a five foot (5') chain link fence at the following locations, if applicable:

- (1) In medians on Santa Rosa from Nueva Street to Houston Street
- (2) San Pedro Creek.
- (3) Around all plant materials at City Hall.
- (4) Around the Spanish Governor's Palace, flagstore, sidewalk and statue.
- (5) On the south side of West Commerce from South Flores to Cameron (behind the sidewalk).
- (6) On South Flores between West Commerce and Dolorosa.

F. An alternate off-street loading area for Fawcett Furniture Company shall be provided by the Carnival Concessionaire. If required by merchants, fencing shall be placed along Dolorosa Street to accommodate merchants.

G. The Carnival Concessionaire shall maintain chemical toilets with large banners above the area and security lighting. The location and number of toilets shall be as required by the Director of Health. All chemical toilets shall be serviced a minimum of every four hours during the hours the carnival is open to the public and once after the carnival closes. If a chemical toilet overflows, the area shall be cleaned immediately upon the next service.

H. Garbage receptacles shall be provided on the Carpool Lot by the Carnival Concessionaire. Locations shall be determined by the City of San Antonio.

I. The Carnival Concessionaire shall coordinate with the respective utility companies to insure that all manholes are covered.

J. Cones and barrels at distances specified by the Public Works Department shall be erected on carnival areas located on City streets in order to delineate closed lanes by the Carnival Concessionaire.

K. The Carnival Concessionaire agrees to execute and deliver to the City Clerk's Office by Monday, April 6, 1998 a Performance Bond in the amount of \$35,000.00 approved by the City as to form and sufficiency, guaranteeing that the Carnival Concessionaire shall comply with all terms, conditions and provisions of this ordinance and all other applicable City Ordinances. The Performance Bond shall be valid through June 26, 1998.

L. The Carnival Concessionaire shall provide and pay for supplementary twenty-four hour security (City Police Officers) for City Hall, Plaza de Armas, and the City Hall Annex at 506 Dolorosa Street from Friday, April 10, 1998 through Monday, April 27, 1998. The Concessionaire shall also provide and pay for security for the south parking area of the Health Department from 7:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M., April 13, 1998 through April 17, 1998 and from April 20, 1998 through April 24, 1998. The officers shall be paid at the rate of time consistent with the Police Collective Bargaining Agreement. All such City documented security costs shall be paid in full to the City of San Antonio no later than seven (7) days after receipt of the final invoices from the Police Department.

M. The Carnival Concessionaire agrees to comply with all other conditions set by the City Manager's Office necessary to insure the public health, safety and welfare.

N. All sidewalks located next to or in the carnival area must remain open to full width during non-carnival operating hours. No encroaching of any sort will be allowed during non-carnival operating hours.

O. A 15' firelane must remain open with no obstructions of any sort on Dolorosa from Santa Rosa to South Flores and Laredo Street from Nueva to Commerce Streets during carnival operating hours.

P. At any time the City's right-of-ways are closed or partially closed, the carnival contractor is obligated to adhere to the City's latest barricade standards and specifications.

Q. The Carnival Concessionaire shall agree to provide substitute parking for the Health Department Parking Lot and the Dolorosa Parking Lot during the Carnival event and incur the cost for the parking.

R. The Carnival Concessionaire shall agree to provide a certified barricade contractor on the first Wednesday and Thursday of carnival operation. The barricade contractor will provide a truck, driver, and 300 night time cones to be utilized as directed by the Police Department Traffic Section. A Police Officer will ride with the driver. The hours this driver, truck and material will be needed shall begin one hour before, one hour after, and during carnival operating hours.

SECTION 4. A copy of the parade route is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes herein as Attachment II. The parade route, as attached, for the 1998 Fiesta Parades (the Battle of Flowers and the Fiesta Flambeau), scheduled for Friday, April 24, 1998 and Saturday, April 25, 1998 is hereby approved. The public streets and ways indicated on **Attachment II** as the 1998 Fiesta Parade Route shall be closed to vehicular traffic during the aforementioned dates, at times specified by the Chief of Police, to facilitate the event and its use of the public property.

SECTION 5. Bleacher placement along the parade route, in accordance with the diagram is attached hereto as **Attachment III** and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes, is approved.

SECTION 6. The agreement with the U.S. Postal Service permitting placement of bleachers along the west side of the Federal Building on Alamo Plaza without blocking the letter collection boxes and the entrance to the ramp on the west side of the Federal Building is approved. The agreement is attached hereto as **Attachment IV** and incorporated by reference herein for all purposes.

SECTION 7. Except for changes made in this Ordinance, the 1998 Fiesta San Antonio celebration shall be conducted in accordance with Ordinance No. 75391 of March 5, 1992. All terms, conditions, requirements and restrictions contained therein shall continue to govern the Fiesta and all Fiesta events unless specifically amended or rescinded herein.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall be effective on the tenth day after passage hereof.






FIESTA 1998 CARNIVAL SITE



CARNIVAL TRAFFIC PLAN




1998 FIESTA PARADE ROUTE





SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance authorizes the closure of certain streets in connection with Fiesta 1998, approves the dates and times for specified Fiesta events, approves the location, dates and times for the Fiesta Carnival and related requirements and conditions, and approves the Fiesta Parade routes.

The proposed ordinance was presented to the City Council Fiesta Committee on Wednesday, March 18, 1998. The Committee reviewed and approved the event schedule and directed that this item be presented to the City Council on Thursday, March 26, 1998.

Staff concurs with the City Council Fiesta Committee recommendation to approve this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The following Fiesta events are approved for the dates and times as outlined below:

SOUTHWEST CRAFT CENTER ART FAIR: Augusta Street from Giraud Street to Navarro Street will be made a temporary one way (eastbound). The street will be closed from noon on Friday, April 17 to 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, April 19 to accommodate unloading and set-up of Fair exhibits and parking of service vehicles.

NIGHT IN OLD SAN ANTONIO: South Presa Street from Market Street to Nueva Street, the median and west bound lanes of Nueva Street from South Alamo Street to 100 feet west of South Presa Street, the east and west lane of South Presa Street from the south side of Nueva Street to the north side of Arciniega Street for VIP parking; the eastbound turning lane of Nueva Street approximately 100 feet west of Alamo Street; southbound curb lane of Alamo Street between Villita and Nueva Streets. Streets are to be closed from Saturday, April 18 at 8:30 a.m. until Sunday, April 26 at 12:00 p.m.

COORDINATION


These events have been coordinated with the City Manager's Office, the City Council Fiesta Committee, the Police Department, the Fire Department, the Public Works Department, the Parks & Recreation Department, the Building Inspections Department, the Metropolitan Health District, the Office of Budget and Management Analysis, the City Attorney's Office and the Fiesta Commission. All of the involved organizations concur with the staff recommendation to approve this request.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The annual City expenditures for Fiesta San Antonio are approximately \$900,000.00. The City provides police officers for traffic control and security at some Fiesta events. The City also provides inspectors, but concessionaires are required to pay the inspection fees as set in the annual budget. Revenues are received from Fiesta sponsors by separate contractual arrangements for rental of city facilities.

The ordinance No. 87566 was approved March 26, 1998.


