

## MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, APRIL 30TH, A.D. 1923, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable O. B. Black, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Lambert, Pfeiffer, Rieden, Wright.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

## -----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS-----

Communication from Mrs Francisco Flores regarding note of \$12,000.00 owed to her by the City was read and held over.

Proposal of the Uvalde Company to lower to a grade established by the City a portion of New Braunfels Avenue, between Allensworth Street and Pershing Avenue, and replace 8" of gravel thereon for the sum of \$150.00 was read and accepted.

Petition of B.G. Irish for permit to lay sewer on Palmetto Avenue was read and granted.

Bid of S.A. Sewer Pipe Co. to supply City with sewer pipe was accepted on recommendation of City Purchasing Agent.

Petition of Sunset System to erect lighted bulletin board at N. St. Mary's Street bridge was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

AN ORDINANCE

Vacating certain streets and alleys which have never been formally accepted by the City of San Antonio.

WHEREAS, it appears that L.P. Peck did on the 15th day of December, 1921, cause to be filed for record in the office of the County Clerk of Bexar County, Texas, a certain plat designated as a portion of Highland Park, an addition to the City of San Antonio, said plat having attached thereto a dedication by said L.P. Peck to the public of the streets and alleys shown on said plat, which was duly recorded in Vol 642, page 38, Deed and Plat records of said County, which plat is here referred to and by reference made a part hereof. the same as if actually attached hereto, and

WHEREAS, it appears that in fact there has been no acceptance, formal or otherwise, by the City of San Antonio or by the public of said dedication, and no acceptance by the City of San Antonio or by the public of the streets and alleys designated on said plat, or any work done on said streets and alleys by said City or by the public; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That all those portions of Avent, Bailey, Schley and McKinley Avenues lying east of South Palmetto Avenue, together with all those portions of the alleys lying east of South Palmetto Avenue and between Highland Boulevard on the north, and Steves Avenue on the South, be, and the same are hereby completely vacated and released from any easement in favor of said City or of the public therein as completely as if said plat had never been recorded or said dedication executed by L.P. Peck.
