

AN ORDINANCE 2012-05-10-0346

AUTHORIZING A CITY COUNCIL PROJECT FUND GRANT ALLOCATION TO THE MAYOR'S COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$21,000 FOR THE PATHWAYS TO LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP FUND.

WHEREAS, the adopted FY 2012 Budget provided for individual City Council district discretionary funds for programs, activities, events, scholarships, goods or services that promote specified municipal public purposes set out in guidelines approved by City Council pursuant to Ordinance 2011-12-08-1011 approved on December 8, 2011; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor's Commission on the Status of Women was established to review matters affecting the employment opportunities, education, social, civic and political participation of women in the American way of life; and

WHEREAS, in keeping with this mission the Commission has established the Pathways to Leadership Scholarship for Bexar County high school female graduates that plan to pursue a degree or certification at any two or four year accredited college, university, vocational or technical school; and

WHEREAS, the Pathways to Leadership Scholarship is eligible for funding under the City Council Project Fund Guidelines and it is the desire of the Mayor and each Councilmember to support this Scholarship Fund ; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. A City Council Project Fund grant allocation to the Mayor's Commission on the Status of Women in the amount of \$21,000 for the Pathways to Leadership Scholarship Fund is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$21,000.00 for this Ordinance is available in Fund 11001000 per the table below, as part of the Fiscal Year 2012 Budget.

SECTION 3. Funds generated by this Ordinance will be deposited into Fund 29604002, Internal Order 211000000064 and General Ledger 45022220.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.






