BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the petition of E. Walter Scott outside the city limits of the City of San Antonio, for a license to use the sanitary sewerage system of the City of San Antonio, through means to be made by the Licensee, is granted hereby subject to the following precedent conditions.
2. That the permit hereby granted is purely temporary and the City reserves the right to revoke same at any time, with or without notice, for any reason that may in the judgment of the City be sufficient.
3. The connection with the City sewer to be made at the risk of the licensee to Lot A. C. B. 8331 i all for Texas ave.

AN ORDINANCE ⁰¹⁻⁸⁹

DEFINING "TRANSIENT MERCHANTS"; PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF TRANSIENT MERCHANTS; PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING OF A LICENSE TAX OR FEE UPON SUCH TRANSIENT MERCHANTS; PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF SUCH LICENSE; FIXING PENALTIES AGAINST TRANSIENT MERCHANTS FOR ENGAGING IN BUSINESS WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, UNTIL A LICENSE IS ISSUED AND PAID FOR AND A RECEIPT IS PROCURED AND POSTED IN EACH PLACE WHERE BUSINESS IS TRANSACTED BY SUCH TRANSIENT MERCHANTS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas:

SECTION 1: The term "Transient Merchant", as used in this Ordinance, shall mean any person, firm, association, partnership or corporation engaging temporarily in a retail or wholesale sale of goods, wares or merchandise in any place in the City of San Antonio, and who, for the purpose of conducting such business, occupies any lot, building, store room, room, hotel room, apartment or structure of any kind. Any person selling or offering for sale goods, wares or merchandise of any character or description, produced, raised or manufactured by the person so selling or offering for sale, and any person handling vegetables, fruits or perishable farm products at any established city market within the City of San Antonio, are hereby specifically excluded from the above definition of transient merchants.

SECTION 2: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association, partnership or corporation, either as principal or agent or representative, to engage in business as a Transient Merchant within the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, without first having obtained a license in the manner hereinafter provided for.

SECTION 3: Any person, firm, association, partnership or corporation desiring to engage in such business as a Transient Merchant, as hereinabove defined, in San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, shall make and file with the City Clerk of San Antonio, Texas, 60 days in advance of said date of opening, a written application stating that he intends to conduct such a business, and further stating the applicant's name, residence, present address, place where he intends to conduct his business, and the kind of business to be conducted. Said application shall further set forth the names and residences of at least four (4) persons acquainted with the reliability and responsibility of the applicant, and the names and residences of five (5), or more, persons with whom the applicant has, in the past, done business. If the said applicant is acting as an agent for another person, the application shall set forth all of the above required facts both as to the agent and as to the principal for whom the agent is acting.

SECTION 4: At the same time that said application is filed with the Clerk of the City of San Antonio, the applicant shall deposit with the Clerk the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars in cash, which said sum shall be retained by the City of San Antonio as a fee for licensing and regulating the applicant and for regulation and investigation after issuance of license, if license is issued. If license be refused, said sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars in cash will be returned by the Clerk of the City of San Antonio to the applicant, or his order.

SECTION 5: After said application has been received and filed by the Clerk of the City of San Antonio, and the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars has been deposited with him, said application shall remain on file for sixty days, during which time, the Clerk shall proceed to investigate the reliability, responsibility and standing of the applicant, as well as the manner and methods used by the applicant in conducting his business. If, after investigation during such period of time, it appears to the Clerk that the applicant is reliable, responsible and of good standing, and that the manner and methods of doing business followed by the applicant are such as would not result in cheating or defrauding the public, the Clerk of the City of San

Antonio shall issue to the applicant a license, which shall expire on December 31st following the date of issuance.

SECTION 6: Said license shall be posted in the place where the business of the Transient Merchant is to be conducted, and shall be posted and kept, at all times, where it can readily be seen by the public.

SECTION 7: After license has been granted by the Clerk of the City of San Antonio, and the doing of business has been started by the applicant, the Clerk shall make or cause to be made regular investigations of the manner in which the licensee is operating his place of business, and if, as a result of said investigations, it appears that the licensee is operating his place of business in a manner contrary to the good and welfare of the public, and in a manner that might result in cheating or defrauding the public, the license granted to the applicant shall be revoked, and after revocation if any business is transacted by any person subject to the provisions hereof, the transaction of such business shall be in violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 8: Transaction of business within the City of San Antonio, as defined in Section 1 of this Ordinance, by any person, firm, association, partnership or corporation, for a period of less than six (6) consecutive months, shall be prima facie evidence that such person, firm, (association, partnership or corporation was a Transient Merchant within the purpose and intent and meaning of this Ordinance.

SECTION 9: Any person, firm association, partnership or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, or any person, firm, association, partnership or corporation who shall begin business without filing the application herein required, or paying the license fee herein prescribed, or who shall fail to post and keep posted said license, as required herein, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and any person, firm, association, partnership or corporation, upon conviction of any violation of this Ordinance, shall be punished by a fine of not less than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars nor more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, and each and every day on which goods, wares and merchandise are sold in violation of this Ordinance or any provision hereof, shall be a separate offense, and shall subject any person, firm association, partnership or corporation so violating the terms hereof, to the penalties herein prescribed.

SECTION 10: This Ordinance shall not repeal or supercede any existing ordinance providing for the levying or collecting of occupation tax from itinerant or transient merchants, but shall be cumulative of and in addition to any such ordinance or ordinances.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That Section 9 of "AN ORDINANCE DEFINING "TRANSIENT MERCHANTS"; PROVIDING FOR THE

REGULATION OF TRANSIENT MERCHANTS; PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING OF A LICENSE TAX OR FEE UPON SUCH TRANSIENT MERCHANTS; PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF SUCH LICENSE; FIXING PENALTIES AGAINST TRANSIENT MERCHANTS FOR ENGAGING IN BUSINESS WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, UNTIL A LICENSE IS ISSUED AND PAID FOR AND A RECEIPT IS PROCURED AND POSTED IN EACH PLACE WHERE BUSINESS IS TRANSACTED BY SUCH TRANSIENT MERCHANTS", which ordinance was read for the first time and laid over on the 16 day of September, A. D. 1937;

2. Be and the same is amended hereby so that the same shall hereafter read as follows:

3. "SECTION 9. Any person, firm, association, partnership or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, or any person, firm, association, partnership or corporation, who shall begin business without filing the application herein required, or paying the license fee herein prescribed, or who shall fail to post and keep posted said license, as required herein, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and any person, firm, association, partnership or corporation, upon conviction of any violation of this Ordinance, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$200.00, and each and every day on which goods, wares and merchandises are sold in violation of this Ordinance, or any provision hereof, shall be a separate offense, and shall subject any person, firm, association, partnership or corporation so violating the terms hereof, to the penalties herein prescribed."

AN ORDINANCE *01-92*

ORDERING AN ELECTION TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO BY

ADDING SECTION 99-A TO AUTHORIZE AN ADVERTISING TAX.

1. WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio have decided to submit to the qualified voters of said City certain amendments to the Charter of the City of San Antonio as specified herein, NOW, THEREFORE:-

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

2. That an election be had, and the same is ordered to be held, on the 23rd day of

November, A. D. 1937, in which election the following proposition shall be submitted:

3. PROPOSITION

"Shall the Charter of the City of San Antonio be amended by adding Section 99-A being a provision authorizing an advertising tax, which addition and amendment to the Charter shall read as follows:

"Section 99-A. The Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio shall levy and collect annually a special tax not exceeding 5 cents on every \$100.00 valuation of the taxable property within the City of San Antonio, to advertise the City of San Antonio to increase the growth of the City, for the improvement thereof and for the benefit of the inhabitants, and the taxes shall be expended in a manner which will promote the general prosperity and welfare of the City of San Antonio."

4. Said election for the adoption of the amendment proposed above, shall be held in accordance with the laws of the state of Texas, and all qualified voters of the City of San Antonio holding a Poll Tax for the current fiscal year, or a certificate of exemption, shall be allowed to vote in said election. The proposition shall be printed in full upon the ballots used in said election and the ballots shall be prepared in such a manner that the voter may vote "YES" or "NO" on said amendment. The manner of holding said election shall be governed by the Laws of the State of Texas, regulating general elections.

5. A copy of this ordinance, signed by the Mayor, shall serve as proper notice of said election; and, the Mayor is directed to cause notice of such election to be published in some newspaper in the City of San Antonio thirty days prior to the date of said election; and, the City Clerk is directed to mail a copy of the proposed amendment to every qualified voter in the City of San Antonio who appears on the Polls of the Tax Collector of Bexar County, for the year ending January 31st preceding said election.

6. This ordinance shall not be passed until twenty days notice has been given of the intention to submit said amendment by publication for ten days in some newspaper published in the City of San Antonio; by "twenty days" is meant from the first date said notice is published.

7. It is ordered by two-thirds vote of the full Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio that this ordinance shall receive final action without having first been read at three several meetings of the Commission.

AN ORDINANCE *01-99*

FOR PERMISSION TO USE THE CITY SANITARY SEWERS GRANTING THE PETITION OF
MRS. ANN DUNCAN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the petition of Mrs. Ann Duncan outside of the City Limits of the City of San Antonio, for a license to use the sanitary sewerage system of the City of San Antonio thru means to be made by the Licensee, is granted hereby, subject to the following precedent conditions.

2. That the permit hereby granted is purely temporary and the City reserves the right to revoke same at any time, with or without notice, for any reason that may in the judgement of the City be sufficient.

3. The connection with the City sewer to be made at the risk of the licensee to Lot 3, County Blk. 37, Harlandale Add.

4. That this permit is intended to cover only the sewerage from the property of the above mentioned petitioner, as same is now situated on said premises at W. Huff Ave, Harlandale Add. outside of the City Limits, and no other person or persons shall be allowed or permitted, by the person to whom this permit is granted, his agents, servants or employees, to use the said City sanitary sewers thru the connection here permitted to be made.

5. That the future purchaser or owner of the above property mentioned in this ordinance, shall comply with all the provisions hereof.

6. That the use to be made of said sewer connection with the City sewerage system shall be subject to the regulation and direction of the City and no use shall be made hereof which might in any way impair the City sewer system or cause same to be obstructed or damaged in any manner whatsoever.

7. That in consideration of the permit hereby granted and the service to be rendered the said licensee hereunder, said grantee agrees to pay the City of San Antonio, as a rental charge, the schedule of fees fixed, and to be fixed, by the Ordinances of the City of San Antonio, said rental commencing on the date of connection made with the City sanitary sewers, but in the event the permit hereby granted is cancelled for any reason, the pro rata amount of said rental shall be returned, less any expense incurred by the City in the premises.

8. That the inspectors of the City shall have free access to the grantee's premises and all buildings situated thereon during the continuance of this permit and while said premises are connected with said City sanitary sewers, for the purpose of inspecting the condition of the plumbing and the use of said sewers, and that all condition as herein embodied are being faithfully observed.
