No. 329 **MC-744** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$12.14 to pay C.B.Smith, refund on Beer Dealers License.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$12.14 be and is hereby appropriated out of the Special Emergency and Contingency Fund, to be paid C.B.Smith as a refund of the unexpired part of a Beer Dealers License heretofore issued to him, said sum being in addition to the sum of \$7.45 heretofore appropriated on January 23, 1919.


Commissioner Wright submitted the following recommendations:
