

AN ORDINANCE 2008-05-08-0378

AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE TEXAS COMPTROLLER OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTS FOR EXPENSES INCURRED FOR THE 2007 BIG 12 FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP AND THE REMITTANCE OF \$76,082.00 TO THE COMPTROLLER IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW.

WHEREAS, the Sporting Event Trust Fund (“Fund”) (Vernon’s Texas Civil Statutes 5190.14, Section 5C) provides a mechanism for governmental entities to receive reimbursement for expenses related to certain premiere sporting events and this Ordinance proposes that the City utilize this statutory tool to recoup eligible expenses that it incurred in hosting the 2007 Big 12 Football Championship; and

WHEREAS, under the statutory provisions and based on the sum of the City’s eligible expenses, the City is now required to remit up to \$76,082.00 to the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts representing the City’s mandatory contribution to the Fund; and

WHEREAS, once the City’s contribution is received, the Comptroller will deposit 6.25 times the City’s contribution into the Fund and the City may then request disbursement from the Fund for allowable 2007 Big 12 Football Championship expenses; and

WHEREAS, based upon the results of the Comptroller’s Office review of the expenses, it is anticipated that the City shall be reimbursed approximately \$551,594.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The remittance of up to \$76,082.00 to the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts for deposit in the Sporting Event Trust Fund is authorized and approved.

SECTION 2. City staff is directed to seek reimbursement of all 2007 Big 12 Football Basketball Championship expenses allowed under the state law.

SECTION 3. The amount of \$76,082.00 is appropriated in SAP Fund 47002000, HOT TAX SUB LIEN REV & REFUND, SAP WBS RB-00076-01-01-28, SAP GL account 6500000– In Kind Revenue. The amount of \$76,082.00 is authorized to be made payable to the Sporting Event Trust Fund and shall be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. Reimbursement in the amount of \$76,082.00 generated by this Ordinance will be deposited in SAP Fund 47002000 HOT TAX SUB LIEN REV & REFUND, WBS Element RB-00076-01-01-28, SAP General Ledger 6500000 In Kind Revenue.

SECTION 5. Reimbursement in the amount up to \$475,512.00 generated by this Ordinance will be deposited in SAP Fund 29018000 HOT/Alamodome Improvement and Contingency Fund, Internal Order 245000000347, SAP General Ledger 6301120 Recovery of Current Year Expenditures.

SECTION 6. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth day after passage.




