

AN ORDINANCE 2011-02-10-0123

ORDERING THE GENERAL CITY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, MAY 14, 2011, AND A RUN-OFF ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, JUNE 11, 2011, IF NECESSARY; AND ALSO SETTING FORTH ELECTION PROCEDURES.

* * * * *

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. ELECTION ORDERED. The San Antonio City Council orders a General Municipal Election be held on Saturday, the 14th of May, 2011, in accordance with all applicable laws of the State of Texas, including but not limited to the Texas Election Code, and the provisions of the Charter of the City of San Antonio, for the purpose of electing the City's Mayor and Council. There shall be eleven offices designated on the ballot as follows:

- Member of Council, Place 1
- Member of Council, Place 2
- Member of Council, Place 3
- Member of Council, Place 4
- Member of Council, Place 5
- Member of Council, Place 6
- Member of Council, Place 7
- Member of Council, Place 8
- Member of Council, Place 9
- Member of Council, Place 10
- Member of Council, Place 11 (Mayor)

SECTION 2. JOINT ELECTION. The City Council also authorizes the May 14, 2011 General Election to be held jointly with other participating local political subdivisions located within Bexar County. The city shall execute an agreement with Bexar County to conduct the Election as a joint election with the other political subdivisions identified in the agreement, which is attached as **Attachment I**, and incorporated in this ordinance for all purposes.

Pursuant to the Texas Election Code, Section 61.012, as amended, the Bexar County Elections Administrator shall provide at least one accessible voting system in each polling place used in the Election. Such voting system shall comply with Texas and federal laws establishing the requirements for voting systems that permit voters with physical disabilities to cast a confidential or secret ballot.

SECTION 3. PRECINCTS AND POLLING LOCATIONS; HOURS OF VOTING. The General Election shall be held as prescribed by law between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 14, 2011, in the precincts of the City of San Antonio as listed in **Attachment II**, which is attached to and incorporated in this ordinance for all purposes.

SECTION 4. VOTING SYSTEM. Voting on Election Day, Saturday, May 14, 2011, shall be conducted by the use of AIS650 Tabulators, paper ballots, or the iVotronic™ touch screen voting system, as determined by the City Clerk and the Bexar County Elections Administrator.

For early voting by mail and for provisional voting at this election, the City Clerk has determined that voting shall be conducted by the use of the AIS650 Tabulators, and paper ballots.

For early voting by personal appearance, beginning on Monday, May 2, 2011, and ending on Tuesday, May 10, 2011, the City Clerk has determined that voting shall be conducted by the use of the iVotronic™ touch screen voting system. The equipment shall be placed at branch offices established for the purpose of conducting early voting by personal appearance at the locations and during the dates and hours listed in **Attachment III**, which is attached to and incorporated in this ordinance for all purposes.

SECTION 5. EARLY VOTING. Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at the branch offices as listed in Attachment II, during the period for early voting, commencing Monday, May 2, 2011, and ending on Tuesday, May 10, 2011. In observance of Mother's Day, Early Voting will not be conducted on Sunday, May 8, 2011. Hours of early voting shall be established by the Bear County Elections Administrator in accordance with the applicable provisions of Texas law.

Electors may cast their early vote by mail. Ballot applications and ballots voted by mail shall be mailed to the early voting clerk as follows:

The last day to receive an application for a ballot to be voted by mail is Friday, May 6, 2011.

SECTION 6. NOTICE. (a) *Form of Notice of Election.* The City Clerk of the City of San Antonio is authorized and directed to prepare a form of the Notice of Election in both English and Spanish, the contents of which comply with the requirements of Section 4.004 of the Texas Election Code and any other applicable law, and will include at the minimum, the nature and date of the election; the location of each election day and early voting polling place; the hours the polls will be open; the locations, dates and times of temporary branch locations of early voting by personal appearance; the early voting clerk's mailing address; and any other information required by other law, and with variations as permitted by applicable law.

(b) *Method of Giving Notice.* Notice of the election shall be given by posting a copy of the Notice of Election, both in English and Spanish, not later than the 21st day before the date set for the election on the bulletin board used for posting notices of the meetings of the City Council of the City. Notice of the election shall also be given by publishing said Notice of Election, both in English and Spanish, at least once, not earlier than the 30th day or later than the 10th day before Election Day, in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of San Antonio. The City Council declares that the *San Antonio Express News* is a newspaper of general circulation within the city.

SECTION 7. CONTRACT FOR ELECTION SERVICES. The City Council will contract with the Bexar County Elections Administrator to conduct this election. The Council shall consider and approve this contract at a future meeting by passage of an ordinance.


SECTION 8. ELECTION MATERIAL. All resident qualified electors of the City shall be permitted to vote at the election and on the day of the election, such electors shall vote at the

designated polling places. The election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code, as amended, and as may be required by any other law. All election materials and proceedings shall be printed in both English and Spanish.


SECTION 9. DATE OF RUN-OFF. If necessary, a run-off election will be held on Saturday, June 11, 2011, in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the provisions of the Charter of the City of San Antonio.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be governed by the provisions of the City Charter and Section 1-15 of the City Code, respectively. As such, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately if passed by the affirmative vote of at least eight members of the City Council; otherwise, this Ordinance shall take effect on the tenth day after passage.





JOINT ELECTION AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into by and between Bexar County Elections Administrator (“ADMINISTRATOR”), acting on behalf of Bexar County; with City of San Antonio (“COSA”); Alamo Heights Independent School District (“AHISD”); San Antonio Independent School District (“SAISD”); Harlandale Independent School District (“HISD”); Judson Independent School District (“JISD”); Northside Independent School District (“NISD”); North East Independent School District (“NEISD”); Southside Independent School District (“SSISD”); the City of Alamo Heights (“COAH”); the City of Balcones Heights (“COBH”); the City of Castle Hills (“COCH”); the City of Fair Oaks Ranch (“COFOR”); the City of Helotes (“COH”); the City of Hill Country Village (“COHCV”); the City of Hollywood Park (“COHP”); the City of Leon Valley (“COLV”); the City of Live Oak (“COLO”); the City of Olmos Park (“COOP”); the City of Shavano Park (“COSP”); the City of Somerset (“COS”); the City of Terrell Hills (“COTH”); the City of Windcrest (“COW”); and the City of Universal City (“COUC”) and they may also be referred to, individually, as an “Entity” or, collectively, as the “Entities,” acting by and through their duly appointed and qualified representatives, pursuant to Texas Election Code Section 271.002(a), for the May 14, 2011 election.

WHEREAS, COSA will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, AHISD will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, HISD will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, JISD will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, NISD will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, NEISD will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, SAISD will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, SSISD will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COAH will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COBH will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COCH will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COFOR will conduct a general and special election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COH will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COHCV will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COHP will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COLV will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COLO will conduct a general and charter election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COOP will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COSP will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COS will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COTH will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COW will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, COUC will conduct a general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Section 271.002(a) of the Texas Election Code authorizes two or more political subdivisions to enter into an agreement to hold elections jointly in the election precincts that can be served by common polling places; and

WHEREAS, the Entities desire that a joint election be held in order to provide a convenient, simple, and cost-saving election to the voters in their respective jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the Entities desire to enter into an agreement setting out their respective duties and responsibilities for the May 14, 2011 election;

NOW THEREFORE, it is agreed that the Entities will hold a joint election on Saturday, May 14, 2011 (the "Joint Election") under the following terms and conditions:

I.

The Entities are each required to enter into their own separate contract with ADMINISTRATOR for election services and will hold elections jointly with other Entities in the election precincts that can be served by common polling places, using joint election officer and clerks as ADMINISTRATOR determines is necessary and appropriate.

II.

The Entities agree to conduct early voting jointly. ADMINISTRATOR will arrange for and handle early voting in person and by mail for the Joint Election in accordance with her contracts with those Entities.

III.

The Entities agree that a single ballot, containing all the measures and offices to be voted on at a particular polling place, shall be used in this Joint Election.

IV.

Each Entity is responsible for its own posting of public notices in connection with the Joint Election. ADMINISTRATOR shall be responsible for publishing a Notice of Election in a newspaper of general circulation in the territory as required of all the Entities under Section 4.003 of the Election Code, and each Entity shall pay ADMINISTRATOR its proportionate share of the publishing cost.

V.

Each Entity is responsible for paying ADMINISTRATOR for any and all other election costs, as applicable to the specific Entity and agreed upon by separate contract for election services between each Entity and ADMINISTRATOR.

VI.

ADMINISTRATOR will tabulate the ballots and provide a set of copies of the affidavit page of each return along with the returns of the election, as agreed upon by separate contract between each Entity and ADMINISTRATOR.

VII.

Each Entity will be responsible for canvassing its respective precinct returns for the Joint Election.

VIII.

Each Entity is responsible for preparing and sending its own Department of Justice Preclearance Submission in the required timely manner.

IX.

The Entities agree to comply with any and all applicable state and federal record retention statutes. Each Entity shall be the custodian of its respective election records.

X.

If an Entity determines not to participate in the Joint Election to be held on Saturday, May 14, 2011, because it has no contested positions, the nonparticipating Entity shall promptly notify ADMINISTRATOR and the other Entities, and this Agreement shall be automatically amended to delete the nonparticipating Entity as a party to the Agreement.

XI.


The undersigned persons are the duly authorized signatories of their Entities, and their signatures represent acceptance of the terms and conditions of this Agreement, as passed and approved by their respective governing bodies.

XII.

This Agreement may be executed in two or more counterparts. Together the counterparts shall be deemed an executed original instrument. The Entities may execute this Agreement and exchange counterparts of the signature pages by means of facsimile transmission, and the receipt of executed counterparts by facsimile transmission shall be binding on the Entities. Following a facsimile exchange, the Entities shall promptly exchange original signature pages.

The precincts allocated by City Council Districts are listed by three categories: Total Precincts, Split Precincts and Precincts that are in the right -of- way of roadways. The types of precincts are defined as:

TOTAL PRECINCT: The entire precinct is geographically located within the City Council District and all the residents are represented by the elected Council Member of that District.

SPLIT PRECINCT (*SPLIT): A precinct that is not totally in the City limits of San Antonio. Parts of the precinct may be shared by other communities or unincorporated Bexar County. These may include right-of-way and parts of the City.

RIGHT-OF-WAY (ROW):** These are precincts which are City limit extensions of major highways and roads due to annexations. Only the right-of-way is in the City limits and does not have any residents.
