

## AN ORDINANCE OF-102

Granting permit to Miss Ana Melas to construct Sanitary Sewer in N. Colorado Street.

BE IT ORBAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO,

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted Miss Ana' Melas to construct an 8" sanitary sewer, beginning at flush tank 31' north of Delgado Street and extending to Rivas Street, according to plat, line and grade made by the City Engineer hereto attached, the cost of said sewer being estimated about Three Hundred and Seventy Five Dollars, the final cost to be filed with the City Engineer within ten days after the completion of the sewer.

Section 2. Said sewer when completed to become the property of the City of San Antonio ad part of its public sewer system.

Section 3. The City Engineer is hereby directed to collect the sum of Thirty Five (\$35.00) Dollars for each and every connection made with said sewer main or house service going into said main and pay the same over to said \_\_\_\_\_ not later than the 10th day of each month following the month in which said connection is made until the sum of actual cost of said sewer shall have been collected and paid over as afore-said, when no further connection fee of Thirty Five Dollars \$35.00 shall be collected.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.

## AN ORDINANCE OF-103

Compromising the claim of the Commercial Bank & Trust Company in regard to the location of the north line of Van Ness Street, between Olive Street and Pine Street, and authorizing the Mayor to execute a quit claim deed in accordance therewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section 1: That for the purpose of compromising and settling a controversy regarding the true location of the north line of Van Ness Street, between Olive Street and Pine Street, forming the south boundary of new City Block 489, the City of San Antonio convey, release and quit claim unto the Commonwealth Bank & Trust Company, its successors and assigns, all its right, title and interest in and to that certain lot, parcel or tract of land out of New City Block 489, held, claimed and designated on the maps and plats on file in the office of the City Engineer as a part of Van Ness Street, lying and being situated north of that certain lot, parcel or tract of land this day conveyed, released and quit claimed to the City of San Antonio by said Commonwealth Bank & Trust Company, and more particularly set out and described by metes and bounds in said instrument, a copy of which is hereto attached and made a part hereof, and as shown on plat recorded in the City Engineer's record Book No. 6, page 81.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of San Antonio be and is hereby authorized, on behalf of the City of San Antonio, to execute a quit claim deed in accordance with and for the purposes expressed in Section 1 hereof.

AN ORDINANCE *OF-104*

Granting permit to Albian Seidel to construct sanitary sewer in Arthur Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio.

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted Albian Seidel to construct an eight inch sanitary sewer in Arthur Street. Beginning at east end of street on New Braunfels Avenue and extending to point 410 feet east of the place of beginning, according to plat, line and grade made by the City Engineer hereto attached; the cost of said sewer being estimated about Three Hundred and Ninety Dollars (\$390.00) to be paid by the said \_\_\_\_\_ . The final actual cost to be filed with the City Engineer within ten (10) days after completion of the sewer.

Section 2. Said sewer when completed to become the property of the City of San Antonio and part of its public sewer system.

Section 3. The City Engineer is hereby directed to collect the sum of Thirty Five Dollars (\$35.00) for each and every connection made with said sewer main or house service going into said main and pay the same over to said Albian Seidel not later than the 10th of each month following the month in which said connection is made until the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ being the actual cost of said sewer shall have been collected and paid over as aforesaid, when no further connection fee of Thirty Five Dollars shall be collected.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent therefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.

AN ORDINANCE *OF-105*

Granting permit to J.W.Judson to construct sanitary sewer in Avant Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio.

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted J.W.Judson to construct an 8 inch sanitary sewer in Avant Street. Beginning at So. Hackberry Street and extending to point 285 feet east of center of Hackberry Street, according to plat, line and grade made by the City Engineer hereto attached; the cost of said sewer being estimated about Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars to be paid by the said J.W. Judson. The final actual cost to be filed with the City Engineer within ten (10) days after the completion of the sewer.

Section 2. Said sewer when completed to become the property of the City of San Antonio and part of its public sewer system.

Section. 3. The City Engineer is hereby directed to collect the sum of Thirty Five \$35.00 for each and every connection made with said sewer main or house service going into said main and pay the same over to said J.W.Judson not later than the 10th of each month following the month in which said connection is made until the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ being the actual cost of said sewer shall have been collected and paid over as aforesaid, when no further connection fee of Thirty Five \$35.00) Dollars shall be collected.

## AN ORDINANCE OF-106

Granting permit to Max Vieweger to construct sanitary sewer in Ave "B" and across Brackenridge Park.

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted Max Vieweger to construct a 10" sanitary sewer to drain swimming pool, beginning at a point opposite lot 12 C.B.6295 and extending to the San Antonio River to a point above road crossing, according to plat, line and grade made by the City Engineer hereto attached; the cost of said sewer being estimated about Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00) to be paid by the said Max Vieweger. ## AN ORDINANCE OF-107

Granting permit to Sam Friedman to construct sanitary sewer in Navidad and Georgia Sts.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio.

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted Sam Friedman to construct an eight 8" sanitary sewer. Beginning at Cincinnati Ave and extending to Georgia Ave, thence on Georgia Ave to Calaveras Street, according to plat, line and grade made by the City Engineer hereto attached, the cost of the sewer being estimated about \$\_\_\_\_\_ to be paid by the said Sam Friedman. The final actual cost to be filed with the City Engineer within ten (10) days after the completion of the sewer.

Section 2. Said sewer when completed to become the property of the City of San Antonio and part of its public sewer system.

The City Engineer is hereby directed to collect the sum of Thirty Five Dollars (\$35.00) for each and every connection made with said sewer main or house service going into said main and pay the same over to said Sam Friedman not later than the 10th of each month following the month in which said connection is made until the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ being the actual cost of said sewer shall have been collected and paid over as aforesaid, when no further connection fee of Thirty Five (\$35.00) Dollars shall be collected.

AN ORDINANCE. *OF-108*

Granting permit to Otto Mintel Jr. to construct sanitary sewer in University Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio.

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted Otto Mintel Jr. to construct an eight 8" sanitary sewer beginning at manhole at University and Meridian and extending to a point 80 feet west of said M.H., according to plat, line and grade made by the City Engineer hereto attached, the cost of said sewer being estimated about One Hundred and Five (\$105.00) Dollars to be paid by the said Otto Mintel Jr.. The final actual cost to be filed with the City Engineer within ten (10) days after the completion of the sewer.

Section 2. Said sewer when completed to become the property of the City of San Antonio and part of its public sewer system.

Section 3. The City Engineer is hereby directed to collect the sum of Thirty Five (\$35.00) for each and every connection made with said sewer main or house service going into said main and pay the same over to said Otto Mintel Jr. not later than the 10th of each month following the month in which said connection is made until the sum of One Hundred and Five (\$105.00) being the actual cost of said sewer shall have been collected and paid over as aforesaid when no further connection fee of Thirty Five Dollars shall be collected.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.

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AN ORDINANCE *OF-109*

An ordinance extending a certain franchise heretofore granted by the City of San Antonio to the Texas Transportation Company, until March 27, 1944. *J*

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the term of a certain franchise heretofore, to-wit, on December 6, 1897, by ordinance of the City Council of the City of San Antonio, duly passed and approved, granted to the Texas Transportation Company, a corporation organized under the laws of Texas and thereafter by an ordinance passed by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, duly passed and approved July 13, 1916, extended for a period of ten years after the expiration of said franchise above referred to, and thereafter by an ordinance of the City of San Antonio passed and approved the 20th day of July, A.D. 1916, extending for 20 years, be and the same is hereby further extended and confirmed to include a period expiring on the 27th day of March, 1944 over the route or line now used by the tracks of said Company, viz., upon and over the following described portions of the public streets of the City of San Antonio, viz., beginning on Austin Street, at the junction of the tracks of the Texas Transportation Company, with the tracks of the G.H. and S.A.R.R. Company, thence across or along Austin Street

to Grand Avenue, thence along Grand Avenue, now known as Eleventh Street, and Jones Avenue. crossing San Antonio River on trestle to Dallas Street; also across Avenue A; this extension, however, to be subject to all provisions, conditions, reservations and stipulations in said original ordinance contained, in so far as applicable, including the existing and applicable obligation on the part of said Company to pay to the City the sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars per annum on June 1st of each year; and shall also be subject to all provisions contained in the existing charter and lawful ordinances of said City, which shall control in any conflict between such charter or ordinances and the provisions of said franchise ordinance; and shall also be subject to all further rights of regulation by law or charter, or by action of the governing body of said City thereunder, which are, or may be, exercised consistently with the constitution of the State of Texas.

AN ORDINANCE *OF-110*

Granting permission to W.A.Baity to construct an 8" sanitary sewer in the alley between Kayton and Rigsby, from Nopal to Walters; also in Nopal, from Kayton to alley south, thence east in alley between Kayton and Highland to Walters Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, permission is hereby granted W.A.Baity to construct 8" sanitary sewers with the necessary manholes and wyes, in the following streets and alleys:

Beginning at the City's main in Nopal Street, between Kayton and Rigsby, thence running east to Walters street.

Beginning at the City's sewer at the center of Kayton and Nopal, thence south in Nopal, half block to alley between Kayton and Highland, thence east in the alley between Kayton and Highland to Walters Street.

according to plat, lines and grades established by the City Engineer hereto attached, cost of said sewer to be paid by the said W.A.Baity.

Section 2. Said sewer, when completed to become the property of the City of San Antonio and part of its public sewer system.
