

AN ORDINANCE 2015-02-26-0149

APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION, AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS UPON AWARD, FOR A JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION GRANT FOR THE RITES OF PASSAGE PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000.00 FROM THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE.

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the efforts undertaken through the Uniform Truancy Case Management Program, the San Antonio Municipal Courts is seeking grant funding to expand the Rites of Passage program, which has proven successful in reducing recidivism and in improving school attendance; and

WHEREAS, upon award, grant funding will support program and administrative costs associated with expansion of the program to include additional school district locations throughout the city, serving juveniles referred by the court; and

WHEREAS, the grant period is September 1, 2015 to August 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, no cash or in-kind matching contributions are required; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The Municipal Court Clerk is hereby authorized to submit an application for and to accept grant funds upon award in an amount up to \$100,000.00 from the Criminal Justice Division (CJD) of the Governor's Office to support the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant (Grant Number 2881601) for the Rites of Passage Program for the period of September 1, 2015 to August 31, 2016. The Municipal Court Clerk is further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said application and acceptance.

SECTION 2. The City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of San Antonio to accept said grant. The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the CJD funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the CJD in full. The City Council designates the Municipal Court Clerk as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency. Municipal Court is partnering with the American Indians in Texas at the Spanish Colonial Missions (AIT-SCM).

SECTION 3. Upon approval of this Ordinance, a new fund and internal order number will be created. A final budget will be provided upon the award of the grant, upon which the above sum will be appropriated from the CJD.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the


City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon receiving at least eight affirmative votes or, if fewer are received, on the tenth day after passage.
