

AN ORDINANCE      2011-09-15-0755

**SELECTING PAPE-DAWSON ENGINEERS, INC. FOR NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,250,000.00 FOR A DOWNTOWN TRANSPORTATION STUDY, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 1, FUNDED FROM 2007 BOND FUNDS AND 2007 BOND SAVINGS.**

**WHEREAS**, in May 2007, the voters of San Antonio approved a \$550 million bond program to address a wide array of public infrastructure throughout the City, including a Downtown Transportation Infrastructure Improvements Project; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of this Downtown Transportation Infrastructure Improvements Project, approximately \$500,000.00 will be dedicated to perform a study of Downtown that would examine all modes of transportation; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 2011-05-19-0398 was approved by City Council which reallocated approximately \$47 million in savings and included \$1 million to be added to the current \$500,000.00 budget for a Downtown Transportation Study to be conducted for the Central Business District of San Antonio; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance selects **Pape-Dawson Engineers Inc.** and authorizes negotiation and execution of a Professional Service Contract in an amount not to exceed \$1,250,000.00 for the Downtown Transportation Study; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** **Pape-Dawson Engineers Inc.** is hereby selected for negotiation and execution of a contract to conduct a Downtown Transportation Study for the Central Business District of San Antonio.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute a Professional Services Agreement with **Pape-Dawson Engineers Inc.** in an amount not to exceed \$1,250,000.00 for the Downtown Transportation Study.

**SECTION 3.** Payment in the amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00013, Downtown Transportation Infrastructure, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to the **Pape-Dawson Engineers Inc.** for a Downtown Transportation Study.

**SECTION 4.** Payment in the amount not to exceed \$750,000.00 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00261, Downtown Circulation Study, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to the **Pape-Dawson Engineers Inc.** for a Downtown Transportation Study.

**SECTION 5.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.






