BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated for the payment of officers and employes for the several accounts and departments as specified in the attached schedule as salaries or wages for services rendered to the City during the month of May, 1918 as per pay rolls:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$175.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund to cover expenses of W.A.King, City Health Officer, to attend a meeting at Washington D.C. called by Surgeon General Gorgas to discuss and plan additional sanitation in cantonments.

Bids for the construction of a loading platform for the garbage department were opened and referred to City Engineers Department for tabulation.


