

AN ORDINANCE **2012-03-08-0183**

IN SUPPORT OF “LEMONADE DAY SAN ANTONIO” SCHEDULED FOR MAY 6, 2012 AND AUTHORIZING THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT TO WAIVE THE TEMPORARY FOOD ESTABLISHMENT PERMIT REQUIREMENT, INCLUDING FEES AND REQUIRED INSPECTIONS FOR PARTICIPATING CHILDREN AND YOUTH.

WHEREAS, in 2007 the Prepared 4 Life organization in Houston, Texas initiated Lemonade Day, a community event to teach youth how to start and run their own businesses; and

WHEREAS, through this program, children learn the entrepreneurial skills necessary to successfully establish and operate a lemonade stand for one day; and

WHEREAS, this experience is meant to teach basic business skills that will equip the youngster to be successful in future endeavors; and

WHEREAS, the program has continued to grow across Texas and other states since the initial event; and

WHEREAS, for the past two years, the Kids in Business Foundation, a 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, worked to establish Lemonade Day in San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, as part of this effort, City Council waived the usual fees for temporary food booths and allowed some of the participants to set up at local parks; and

WHEREAS, this same process is being requested for the 2012 event; **NOW THEREFORE:**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City supports “Lemonade Day San Antonio” scheduled for May 6, 2012 and authorizes the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District to waive the temporary food establishment permit requirement, including fees and required inspections for participating children and youth.

SECTION 2. The City Council directs staff to allow Lemonade Day participants to set up on certain City parks where stands can be accommodated. A copy of the list of parks to be used on Lemonade Day is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


