

AN ORDINANCE 89700

CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A BOND ELECTION HELD ON MAY 1, 1999; AND OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THERWITH.

* * * * *

WHEREAS, on January 28, 1999, the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, (the "City") ordered an election to be held on May 1, 1999 for the purpose of determining whether the resident, qualified electors of the City would authorize the issue of general obligation bonds by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and investigated all matters pertaining to this election, including the ordering, notices, election officers, holding, and returns thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby canvasses the returns of this election, at which there was submitted to all resident, qualified electors of the City for their action thereupon, the following propositions:

and in providing for the above improvements, the City Council shall have the option to utilize other funds available for such purposes, and provided, however, the City Council, in its discretion, may apply funds set aside for any given project listed above under the heading "Streets - Metropolitan Planning Organization Match" for constructing other street and pedestrian improvements and drainage and amenities incidental thereto should the Metropolitan Planning Organization elect not to provide matching funding for the given project, and after making due provision for all other projects listed above may use any excess funds for constructing other street and pedestrian improvements and drainage and amenities incidental thereto, and acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto: such bonds to mature serially or otherwise not more than forty (40) years from their issued date; and any issue or series of said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of said City Council, provided that such interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of said bonds; and shall the City Council be authorized to levy and pledge and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity?"

and in providing for the above improvements, the City Council shall have the option to utilize other funds available for such purposes, and after making due provision therefore the City Council, in its discretion, may use any excess funds for acquiring, constructing, improving, renovating and equipping fire and police facilities, acquiring public safety technology improvements, and acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto: such bonds to mature serially or otherwise not more than forty (40) years from their issued date; and any issue or series of said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of said City Council, provided that such rate of interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of said bonds; and shall the City Council be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity?"

WHEREAS, the City Council has diligently inquired into the poll lists and the official election returns which were duly and lawfully made to this City Council by the judges and clerks holding and conducting such election and which show separately the votes cast in the election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds and determines that the canvassing of the election returns has been conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Code, the City's Home Rule Charter (the "Charter"), and applicable law; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1: The City Council of the City of San Antonio officially finds, determines, and declares that the election was duly and properly ordered, that proper legal notice of such election was duly given in the English language and the Spanish language, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to the election, that the election was duly and legally held, that all resident, qualified electors of the City were permitted to vote at the election, that due returns of the results of the election have been made and delivered, and that the City Council of the City has duly canvassed such returns, all in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and of the United States of America, the Charter, and the ordinance calling the election.

SECTION 2. The City Council of the City officially finds, determines, and declares that a MAJORITY of the resident, qualified electors of the City voting in such election voted for the qualified electors of the City voting in such election voted FOR the authorization and issuance of \$140,200,000.00 of bonds and the levy and pledge of the tax in payment thereof, as submitted in the Propositions; that the Propositions carried at the election; and that the City Council is hereby accordingly authorized to issue and sell general obligation bonds in accordance with the authority granted in the Propositions and with the law.

SECTION 3. The City Council hereby finds in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code, as amended (the "Code"), that the following votes were cast in the election by voters who were resident, qualified electors of the City, as follows:

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.


