SUBJECT: Request to Amend Noise Nuisance Ordinance

Issue Proposed for Consideration

I ask for your support for the inclusion of the following item on the agenda of the earliest available meeting of the Governance Committee:

I request your support for City staff to amend *Sec. 21-52.-Noise nuisance enumeration*, so as to reduce the decibel threshold for property defined in sec. 21-52 (a), (10)-(12) to 63 decibels when such property abuts areas that are zoned residential.

Brief Background

Often times factors such as, but not limited to, a low cloud deck or directional wind changes impact the measuring for noise emanating from business, industrial and entertainment zoned property as defined by Chapter 35 (Unified Development Code), when measured from property under separate ownership.

The intent of the amendment to *Sec. 21-52* requested here is in support of the peace and serenity of residential areas in close proximity to business, industrial and entertainment zoned property as defined by Chapter 35 (Unified Development Code) where noise nuisance is concerned.





