THURSDAY, DECEMBER 8TH, A.D.1921, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable O. B. Black, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Pfeiffer, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police:

The resignation of John B. Banks from the position of City Market Master was read and accepted, to take effect December 9, 1921.

Petition of property owners along Laver Street and McKinney Place to have name of street changed to E.Woodlawn Avenue, was granted on motion of the Commissioner of Streets, etc.

Bids for binding tax receipts were opened and read, and on motion of the Commissioner of Taxation the Purchasing Agent was directed to award the bid to lowest bidder.

Bids for supplying the City with cement were rejected, and the City Purchasing Agent instructed to advertise for new bids.

Commissioner Wright called up an ordinance regulating traffic on the streets of the City, previously introduced at a meeting held Nov. 10, 1921, ~~was~~ which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Black, Pfeiffer, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.
