

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS HELD ON THE  
16TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, A.D.1920, 3.30 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, and Commissioners Coy and Heuermann.

The Mayor announced the purpose of the meeting to be for the adoption of an ordinance providing for the extension of Brooklyn Avenue.

The ordinance was read by Commissioner Heuermann and adopted upon roll call by the following vote, to-wit: Ayes, Bell, Coy and Heuermann.

AN ORDINANCE *MD-925*

Providing for the widening and extension of Brooklyn Avenue and making appropriation therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to acquire on behalf of the City of San Antonio certain land necessary for the widening and extension of Brooklyn Avenue as follows, to-wit: From Emma Reed, a part of lot 12 in City Block 820; fronting 17.1 feet on Augusta Street and extending along the south side of Brooklyn Avenue to an alley and fronting 11.8 feet on said alley, for the consideration of \$1000.00; from Wolf Jaffe a part of lot 6 in City Block 820, fronting 14.4 feet on an alley and extending along the side of said Brooklyn Avenue to Oakland Street and fronting 10.4 on said Oakland Street, for the consideration of \$3,000.00; and from Julius H. Holmgreen a part of Lot A-1 in City Block 834, being a strip of land 55.6 feet wide extending from Oakland Street to the San Antonio River between curved lines, so as to cross the San Antonio River and connect with Seventh Street, for the consideration of \$7,500.00

SECTION TWO: That for the purpose of paying the consideration for the property described in Section One hereof, the sum of \$11,500.00 is hereby appropriated out of the Street Widening Fund arising from the proceeds of the 1919 Bond Issue, warrants for which shall be drawn as follows: To the order of Emma Reed, for the sum of \$1000.00; to the order of Wolfe Jaffe, the sum of \$3000.00; to the order of Julius H. Holmgreen the sum of \$7,500.00, said warrants to be delivered to the respective payees on the execution and delivery to the City of San Antonio of general warranty deeds approved as to form by the City Attorney, conveying said respective parcels of land to the City of San Antonio.
