

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, JANUARY 16TH, A. D. 1933, 10:00 A.M.

PRESENT: Honorable C. M. Chambers, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Bushick, Rubiola, Steffler, Wright.

On motion, of Commissioner Steffler, duly seconded and carried, the reading of the Minutes of the meeting of January 9th, was dispensed with and ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

Mr. A. L. Becker, representing the Unemployment Committee, presented to the Commissioners a proposition to construct a stadium on City land adjoining Brackenridge Park. After some discussion it was agreed that the Commissioners, acting as a Committee of the Whole, would meet all parties interested at the site of the proposed improvement, Wednesday, January 18th, 1933, at 2 P. M. to further discuss the matter.
