REPEALING AN ORDINANCE AND RE-APPROPRIATING \$600.00 OUT OF SAN ANTONIO AIRPORT FUND TO PAY FOR RENTAL OF EQUIPMENT ON W. P. NO. 17860 AT THE NEW MUNICIPAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, An Ordinance passed and approved October 19, 1942, being Council Appropriation No. 290, appropriating \$600.00 out of Airport Fund of 1941, payable to E. D. Goodloe for rental of equipment including all labor, repairs, maintenance and operating expenses on W. P. No. 17860 at the New Municipal Airport, and

WHEREAS, the said amount of \$600.00 appropriated out of Airport Fund of 1941 to pay E. D. Goodloe, was appropriated in error; THEREFORE:


AN ORDINANCE (1758)


