Hearing was called on matter of rezoning Proposition (a), W. Ashby Place between San Pedro and Breeden to be "F" local retail.

After discussion the matter was referred to the City Manager for referral to the City Attorney as to legal aspects.

The matter of rezoning Jackson St. in NCB 354 was then brought up. Mr. John Hagy representing the owner of much of the property involved and Mr. DuBose the owner and others entered a plea for expansion of this business district.

Mr. Charles Biery, representing a large delegation of neighbors to the property, made a vigorous protest, contending that there was no justification for any such drastic change in the use of this property.

This matter was also referred to the City Manager for referral to the Legal Department for investigation of legal aspects.

Mr. Lozano asked for a two weeks leave of absence for Mayor White which was granted. He announced that the Mayor asked that his salary for the time out revert to the City.

Mr. Roper introduced the following ordinance which was adopted by a roll call vote of 8 Ayes, one absentee, with the announcement that the City Ordinance of January 1, consolidating the Police & Fire Civil Service Commission into the overall City Public Service Commission was in every respect legal but that litigation was delaying organization of the Civil Service.
