

A RESOLUTION **2014-07-22-0027R**

ACKNOWLEDGING A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 2; AND INITIATING PROCEDURES TO SELECT A REPLACEMENT COUNCIL MEMBER.

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WHEREAS, on Tuesday, July 22, 2014, Council Member Ivy Taylor, District 2 representative on the City Council, was elected by the City Council as mayor, filling the vacancy caused by the appointment of Julián Castro as Secretary of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, this event caused a vacancy in the office of City Council District 2; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of San Antonio City Charter, Section 8, a vacancy on the Council may be filled by a majority vote of the remaining members until an election may be held to fill the office for the remainder of the unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2010-05-06-0375 establishes procedures for the appointment of temporary replacement Council Members in the event of a vacancy; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council acknowledges the vacancy in the office of City Council, District 2.

SECTION 2. The City Council directs the City Clerk to immediately post notice on the City website and publish, as soon as possible, advertisements in the local newspaper, inviting qualified residents of the district to submit applications, letters of interest, résumés, and disclosure statements to the City Clerk.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is authorized to begin accepting applications, letters of interest, résumés and disclosure statements on Monday, July 28, 2014.

SECTION 4. The deadline to submit applications, letters of interest, résumés, and disclosure statements to the City Clerk is 5:00 p.m., August 8, 2014.

SECTION 5. The City Council will interview qualified applicants of interest at the Council's "B" Session on Wednesday, August 13, 2014, and select up to three applicants to be interviewed at the Council's "A" Session on Thursday, August 14, 2014.

SECTION 6. The City Council will vote on the applicants for District 2 at the Council's "A" Session on Thursday, August 14, 2014. The successful applicant for appointment will be sworn in and take office at that meeting.

SECTION 7. In accordance with the City Charter requirements, a Special Election shall be called by a subsequent ordinance, to be held on the next uniform election date, November 4, 2014, to elect the replacement Council Member.

SECTION 8. This resolution is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.





Notification Process



- In accordance with Ordinance 2010-05-06-0375, the notification process is as follows:
 - The City Clerk posts Notice of Vacancy On-Line by close of business on Wednesday, July 23, 2014.
 - The City Clerk publishes Notice of Vacancy in the Express-News and La Prensa on Sunday, July 27, 2014.

Application Period



- The Application Period is from Monday, July 28 through 5 pm on Friday, August 8, 2014 (10 business days).
- Applicants shall complete an Application and submit Letters of Interest, a Resume, and Personal Financial Statement/Financial Disclosure Report Addendum.
- The City Clerk will review Applications and forward same to the Mayor and City Council.

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Review and Appointment Process



- On Wednesday, August 13, 2014 during the “B” Session; the Mayor and City Council will select up to 3 Applicants to interview.
- On Thursday, August 14, 2014 during the Regular City Council Meeting, the Mayor and City Council will Vote on the Replacement for the Vacant Council Seat.
- The Appointee will be immediately sworn-in by the City Clerk.

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
