

## SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO

MONDAY, MARCH 23RD. A.D. 1942 11:00 A.M.

PRESENT: Mayor, C. K. Quin, presiding, and Commissioners Hein, Steffler, and Anderson.

ABSENT: Commissioner Davis.

The Clerk read the following call:

March 23, 1942

TO THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Gentlemen:

Under the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of San Antonio, by the Charter of the City of San Antonio, I call you hereby in a Special Meeting required for the good of the City of San Antonio to convene at 11:00 A.M., on the 23rd day of March, A.D. 1942, to act upon:-

AN ORDINANCE (1056)

REPEALING A PORTION OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$46.00 TO REIMBURSE CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO FEES PAID BY THEM FOR COMMERCIAL TRUCK DRIVERS' LICENSES," PASSED AND APPROVED ON THE 28TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1941, AND TRANSFERRING THE UNUSED PORTION OF SAID APPROPRIATION BACK TO THE 1941 GENERAL FUND - STREET MAINTENANCE

A RESOLUTION (1058)

DIRECTING THE CITY PURCHASING AGENT TO ADVERTISE FOR PROPOSALS TO FURNISH THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, RECREATION DEPARTMENT, WITH ITS REQUIREMENTS, FOR THE SUMMER SEASON OF 1942, OF SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE SOLUTION NEEDED IN THE CHLORINATION OF CITY SWIMMING POOLS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the City Purchasing Agent be and he is hereby directed to advertise, in the manner provided by law, for proposals to furnish the City of San Antonio, Recreation Department, with its requirements, for the summer season of 1942, of sodium hypochlorite solution needed in the hypo-chlorination of the City swimming pools. It is estimated that approximately 10,000 gallons of 10 per cent sodium hypochlorite solution will be needed; if other strengths of solution are offered as substitutes, 12 per cent sodium hypochlorite solution is the strongest which will be considered.

2. Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Purchasing Agent until 10:00 o'clock A.M., Thursday, April 2nd, 1942, at which time bids will be opened in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, of the City of San Antonio.

3. Specifications and delivery dates and requirements are on file in the office of the City Purchasing Agent.

4. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
