

AN ORDINANCE **62969**

ORDERING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON AUGUST 9, 1986, ON THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CITY CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO PROVIDE FOR A LIMIT ON CITY BUDGET INCREASES TO BE BASED ON ANNUAL POPULATION GROWTH AND THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed with the City Clerk on the 5th day of May, 1986, requesting that an election be held on the 9th day of August, 1986, on a proposed amendment to the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of May, 1986, the City Clerk verified that the petition was signed by the required number of qualified electors and, therefore, certified their petition; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has indicated its support for an election to be held on August 9, 1986, for that purpose; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. A special election is hereby ordered to be held in the City of San Antonio on Saturday, the 9th day of August, 1986, at which time there shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the City of San Antonio, the proposition to amend the Charter of the City of San Antonio by adding a Section 83a, reading as follows:

"Section 83a. LIMITATION ON BUDGET INCREASES TO BE BASED ON ANNUAL POPULATION GROWTH AND THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI). The budget referred to herein is the 'All Funds Budget Total Net Appropriations for Total Operating/Capital Projects'. Prior to the adoption of the budget, the City Manager shall calculate the percentages of population growth in the preceding 12-month (fiscal year) for the City of San Antonio. The City Manager shall also calculate the annual percentage of inflation for the same 12-month period (fiscal year) based on the CPI, or any other valid measure of municipal inflation. In enacting the annual budget, the Council may not exceed the prior year's budget by more than the combined percentages of population and inflation as enumerated above. The Council shall not adopt a budget that exceeds the previous year's budget plus a percentage increase equal to population and inflation, for any and all purposes, unless such added budget requirements are first submitted to the qualified voters of the City of San Antonio for their approval at an election duly called and held for such purposes. This charter provision shall prevail over any other conflicting language in this charter. If any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this amendment shall be declared unconstitutional by a valid judgment or decree of any court of valid jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences or paragraphs."

SECTION 2. Said election shall be held at the polling places in the regularly prescribed voting precincts of the City of San Antonio between the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock P.M. The polling place locations are shown in Exhibit A, and the absentee substation voting sites are shown in Exhibit B.

SECTION 3. All qualified electors residing in the City of San Antonio shall be eligible to vote at said election.

SECTION 4. The foregoing amendment shall be submitted on the ballot so that each voter may vote "Yes" or "No"; and said ballots shall have written or printed thereon the following:

Shall the Charter of the City of San Antonio be amended by adding a Section 83a providing for a limit on City budget increases that will be based on the annual population growth and the consumer price index.

SECTION 5. Notice of said election shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation pursuant to law. The manner of holding said election shall be governed by the laws governing such elections.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk is authorized to negotiate with the Bexar County Elections Administrator with regard to holding the election jointly with the Alamo Community College District election to be held on August 9, 1986, on the proposed expansion of the Alamo Community College District's boundaries and run-off election. A contract will subsequently be presented to the City Council for formal approval and adoption, if a joint election agreement is successfully negotiated.


