

AN ORDINANCE 2011-09-01-0719

AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO HIGH-SIERRA ELECTRONICS CONSTRUCTION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$492,465.00, TO IMPROVE LOW WATER CROSSINGS IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO.

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WHEREAS, the Low Water Crossing Remediation Program provides for short-term improvements to low water crossings in San Antonio by identifying areas of high water rescues and 311 calls; and

WHEREAS, the improvements include some, if not all, of the following: High Water Detection System (HWDS), Automated Gates and Alternate Route Signs; and

WHEREAS, the low water crossing areas include Lockhill east of White Bonnet, Leslie Road southwest of Braun Road, Old Seguin at Salado Creek, Southton Road west of IH37, South Hausman Road north of Prue Road, and 151 Access Road near Pinn off ramp; and

WHEREAS, all low water crossings will become part of the San Antonio Flood Emergency Program managed by the San Antonio Office of Emergency Management; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by **High-Sierra Electronics** in the amount not to exceed \$492,465.00; and

WHEREAS, approval of this Ordinance will be a continuation of the City's effort to provide early warning and alternative routes for drivers in a heavy rain event; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid of **High-Sierra Electronics** in the amount not to exceed \$492,465.00 for the Contract to improve low water crossings in San Antonio is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 2. A Construction Contract is hereby awarded to **High-Sierra Electronics**.

SECTION 3. The following financial adjustments are hereby approved:

- a) Funding in the amount of \$492,465.00 for this ordinance is available in Fund 29070000, Cost Center 2304020009 and General Ledger 5201040, as part of the Fiscal Year 2011 Budget.

- b) Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to **High-Sierra Electronics** and should be encumbered with a purchase order.
- c) The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.


