AN ORDINANCE **64661**

AMENDING ORDINANCE 64382, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 15, 1987, BY EFFECTING CHANGES TO CERTAIN POLLING PLACE SITES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 64382 is hereby amended so as to effect the following changes to polling place sites as follows:

Precincts 1014 and 1015: From Stonewall Elementary to Flanders Elementary.

Precinct 1080: To be combined with Precinct 2047 from Westlakes Mercado Mall to Meadow Village Elementary.

SECTION 2. The propositions to be voted upon at this election shall be as follows:

AGAINST } authorized to issue bonds for police and crime
control facilities in the amount of \$12,650,000.00 for
construction of a Police Training and Career Development

the land acquisition/construction of a police sub-station
in the northwest area of the City?

SUMMARY:

This ordinance amends Ordinance 64382, effective January 15, 1987, by effecting changes to the polling place sites as follows:

Precincts 1014 & 1015: From Stonewall Elementary to Flanders Elementary.

Reason: The location was changed at the request of the Harlandale Independent School District. New location will be across the street.

Precinct 1080: Will be combined with Precinct 2047 from Westlakes Mercado Mall to Meadow Village Elementary.

Reason: We could not find any judges residing in the precinct to work the election.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

After the call of the election, the Harlandale Independent School District advised us that they prefer voting at Flanders instead of Stonewall because they feel that Flanders is a much better place to vote. It is located right across the street. In Precinct 1080 we could not find any judges who actually live in the precinct to work the election and, therefore, we had to combine it with another precinct.
