No. 407 **MC-859** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$81.75 out of Back Tax Fund to pay sundry merchants bills.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Eighty one and 75/100 dollars (\$81.75), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the Back Tax Fund to pay sundry merchants bills per itemized invoices on file in office of City Auditor.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.

No. 408 **-860** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$50.00 to pay C.M.Deckman for clearing brush from Nebraska Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$50.00 be and is hereby appropriated from the 1918 General Fund to pay T.M.Deckman for clearing brush and grubbing Nebraska Street.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom and the same shall take effect at once.

Petition of Womens City Committe for establishment of Detention Home for delinquent boys and girls, was read and referred to City Attorney.




