

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, APRIL 19TH, A.D.1917, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable J.R.Lambert, Mayor Pro-tem, presiding, and Commissioners Garland and Kearny. Absent, Mayor Brown, and Commissioner Uhr.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

Petition of Merchants Transfer Company for permit to install gasoline equipment at 227 St. Mary Street, was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

Commissioner Kearny made the following recommendations:

That petition of San Antonio Traction Company for permit to lay an emergency track on Salinas Street be granted. Adopted.

That petition of S.A.Traction Company, for permit to construct the Highland Park Car line on Westfall Avenue from Hackberry to Olive Streets, and on Olive from Westfall to Rigsby, be granted. Adopted.

That petition of Western Union Tel. Co. for permit to lay conduit across West Commerce Street at North Smith, be granted, provided that condition requiring payment of \$100.00 as per ordinance for cutting into pavement. Adopted.

Petition of Geo. F.Dullnig, et al. requesting that moving picture operators be examined, was read and referred to City Attorney to draw up ordinance.

The following petitions were granted on recommendation of the Building Inspector:

Stires Out Door Adv. Co., for permit to erect a bill board along river above Houston Street Bridge, provided the Out Door Adv. Co. make proper bond, and construct the bill board on line to be given by City Engineer. Adopted.

A.M.Berry, for permit to operate moving picture show in Berman Building, Commerce St. Adopted.

No. 337 **MB-538** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$44.16 to pay Express charges on Beavers shipped to Zoo at Brackenridge Park.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Forty Four and 16/100 (\$44.16) Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1916 Zoo Fund to pay Express charges on Beavers shipped from Yellowstone Park for the Zoo at Brackenridge Park; warrant to be made payable to Fred Fries, City Clerk.
