REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO HELD IN
THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, ON
WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 21, 1956 AT 9:30 A.M.

PRESENT: FRIEDRICH, BAINES, PASSUR, CRUMRINE, WINTON, KUYKENDALL, OLIVARES, DANIELS,
SAN MARTIN

Mayor J. Edwin Kuykendall presiding.

Invocation by Rev. Gus Schulze, Aldersgate Methodist Church.

On motion of Mr. Baines, seconded by Mr. Passur, the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with.

The Mayor called on the Planning Director to present matters pertaining to zoning. The first item was the recommendation of the Planning Commission that the City Code be amended as follows:

- (1) Sec. 64-35 be amended by adding a new use as follows: "Poultry killing and dressing, and storage of live poultry, where completely enclosed within a building."
- (2) Sec. 64-35 be amended by adding the following words "except a one family dwelling, a two family dwelling, an apartment, a boarding house, a lodging house or group housing".
- (3) Sec. 64-36 be amended by deleting the following words "Residence, Apartment."
- (4) Sec. 64-33 be amended by adding a new sub paragraph to read as follows:
"(12) In the "E" Apartment District, professional offices providing office space for the following are permitted: physicians, surgeons, and all professions licensed under the Basic Science Act of the State of Texas, lawyers, engineers, architects, real estate brokers, dentists, artists, musicians, insurance agents, and accountants, provided that no nameplate, bulletin board, or sign exceeding twelve (12) square feet in area be permitted."

Mr. Martin, the Planning Director, explained each proposed change and they each voted upon separately.

Proposition (1) was approved by the following vote: AYES, Friedrich, Baines, Passur, Crumrine, Winton, Kuykendall, Olivares, Daniels, San Martin; NAYS, None.

Propositions (2), (3), & (4) were discussed; no one appeared to be heard the hearing on them was closed but action by the council on the recommendation of the Planning Commission was indefinitely held in suspense by the following vote: AYES, Friedrich, Baines, Passur, Crumrine, Winton, Kuykendall, Olivares, Daniels, San Martin; NAYS, None.

The Council then approved the recommendation of the Planning Commission on Proposition (1) by adoption of the following ordinance.

Zoning Case No. 722 to rezone Lots 7 & 8, New City Block 10599 on Loop 13 near Old Seguin Road from "A" TEMPORARY RESIDENCE to "L" MANUFACTURING DISTRICT was next called up. Mr. Martin, the Planning Director, explained the nature of the area and the reasons for the recommended change. No one else appeared to be heard. On motion of Mr. Baines, seconded by Mr. Friedrich, the Council approved the recommendation of the Planning Commission by passage of the following ordinance, by the following vote: AYES, Friedrich, Baines, Passur, Crumrine, Winton, Kuykendall, Olivares, Daniels, San Martin; NAYS, None.

Zoning Case No. 734 to rezone Lots 2, 3, 4, Block A, New City Block 10033 from "B" RESIDENCE DISTRICT to "F" LOCAL RETAIL DISTRICT, located on Eureka Street, was next called up. This case had been heard on October 18th and was referred back to the Planning Commission for study. The Council later reconsidered the motion by which it was referred back and sent the matter to the City Manager for a report. The Manager had made an investigation which bore out the statement made by Mrs. Flora Belle Cook on October 18 that business buildings had been erected in "B" Residential District without a permit. Mrs. Cook again appeared and protested the change in zoning because of damage to her adjoining property. Councilman Baines stated that he had visited the site and his opinion was that the property was not suited for residential use but was O.K. for retail business. Mr. M. M. Hughes, Attorney for the petitioner, stated that the building erected had been placed there in error.

Mr. Martin, the Planning Director, gave the recommendation of the Planning Commission that the change be granted for Lots 2 & 3, but not for Lot 4. Upon motion of Mr. Daniels, seconded by San Martin, the recommendation of the Planning Commission was approved by passage of the following ordinance; the vote being AYES, Friedrich, Baines, Passur, Crumrine, Winton, Kuykendall, Olivares, Daniels, San Martin; NAYS, None.
