MAKING A CONTRACT FOR A TRUCK WITH
JOE V. GONZALES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That this ordinance makes and manifests a contract between the City of San Antonio, and the undersigned, hereinafter called Contractor. WITNESSETH:-

2. That the Contractor will supply to the City of San Antonio one, four (4) yard dump truck, to deliver gravel, furnished by the City from City gravel pit to streets designated by the City Engineer at a rate per load to be agreed upon with the City Engineer.

3. That the Contractor shall, at his own expense, employ the driver, and maintain the truck in a good state of repair.

4. The Contractor will use the truck to haul gravel to the above designated streets and location, at the time and place directed by the City Engineer of the City of San Antonio; and will accomplish this work in a manner and by the method chosen by the Contractor.

5. This contract may be terminated by either party at will.

6. It is the intention of the parties that the Contractor will be independent; and that neither the relation of principal and agent nor master and servant shall exist.

7. This instrument in writing constitutes the entire agreement of accord and satisfaction between the parties, there being no other written or parole agreement with any officer or employee of the City; it being understood by the undersigned that the Charter of the City of San Antonio requires all contracts to be in writing and approved by ordinances, before the City is bound.

ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF E. C. HALL, DOING BUSINESS AS WAHRMUND-LOGAN CO. TO CONSTRUCT A COMPLETE NEW GRAVITY SEWER LINE FROM MONTCLOVA STREET, NORTHWARD ALONG THE MARTINEZ CREEK CHANNEL TO MANGOLIA AVENUE, COMPRISING SECTION ONE OF THE NORTH SIDE SEWER MAIN: AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE CONTRACT: AND APPROPRIATING \$144,065.20 OUT OF THE SANITARY SEWER PLANT & SYSTEM A-47 FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. The proposal of E. C. Hall, doing business as Wahrmond-Logan Co. 422 Hays Street, San Antonio, Texas, dated June 9, 1949, attached hereto and made a part thereof, for the construction of a complete new Gravity Sewer Line from Montclova Street Northward along the Martinez Creek Channel to Mangolia Avenue, and which is the Martinez Creek Sewer comprising Section One of the North Side Sewer, in accordance with plans and specifications of the City Engineer, for a total cost of \$144,065.20, be and the same is accepted hereby.

2. That the Mayor is authorized hereby to execute contract for this work on the City Standard Construction Contract form

3. That all other bids are hereby rejected.

4. That \$144,065.20 be and the same is appropriated hereby out of the Sanitary Sewer Plant and System A-47 Fund, to Wahrmund-Logan Co. for this work, to be paid on estimates approved by the City Engineer.

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AN ORDINANCE No. 9865

AN ORDINANCE EXPRESSING AN AGREEMENT FOR THE JOINT OPERATION OF THE ROBERT B. GREEN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AND ITS SUBSIDIARY HOSPITALS AND/OR INSTITUTIONS, BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE COUNTY OF BEXAR, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE OFFICERS WHO ARE TO MANAGE AND CONTROL THE SAME, PRESCRIBING THEIR TERMS OF OFFICE, PRESCRIBING THEIR POWERS AND DUTIES, PROVIDING FOR THE FINANCING OF MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS, PROVIDING THAT THE OPERATION OF SAID HOSPITAL AND ITS SUBSIDIARY HOSPITALS AND/OR INSTITUTIONS SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE A STRICTLY GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County, Texas, and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio have heretofore cooperated with each other in the establishment, building, equipment and maintenance of the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital, and it is deemed advisable by the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar that a new agreement be made between the aforesaid governing bodies of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar, Texas, respectively, which said agreement shall take the place of and be in lieu of any and all agreements in the premises heretofore made by and between the said political subdivisions; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the laws of the State of Texas, and to the Charter and Ordinances of the City of San Antonio, Texas, it is deemed advisable that the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital, heretofore constructed and maintained jointly by the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar, as well as the Robert B. Green Annex and the Tuberculosis Colony situated in Bexar County, both of which are operated in connection with said Hospital, shall be under the joint control of the City of San Antonio and Bexar County, Texas, as hereinafter provided; and,

WHEREAS, it is further deemed advisable that the joint control and management, as well as the equipment and maintenance of such hospital and its adjuncts, shall be placed under the management of a Board of Managers, as hereinafter constituted, subject to the terms and provisions of the laws of the State of Texas and the terms and provisions of this agreement; and,

WHEREAS, an emergency exists endangering the public health by reason of inadequate funds for the more complete operation of said hospital during the ensuing year, and the officials of the municipalities of Alamo Heights, Terrell Hills and Olmos Park have indicated their desire to participate with the City of San Antonio in providing funds for the ensuing year during which it is not necessary for the City of San Antonio to participate on an equal basis with the County of Bexar in the operation and maintenance of said hospital and the institutions connected therewith, and it is therefore, desirable to provide by this agreement for the twelve months ending May 31, 1950, on a different basis from the permanent plan for the joint operation and maintenance of said institutions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section 1: That the term "County" as used herein shall mean the County of Bexar, Texas, acting by and through the Commissioners' Court of the said County, and the term "City" as used herein shall mean the City of San Antonio, Texas, acting by and through the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio; that the term "Hospital", or Hospital System" as used herein shall mean and include the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital, The Robert B. Green Annex, and the Tuberculosis Colony, together with such other hospitals and/or institutions as may become a part of the said Hospital System by mutual agreement of the City and County aforesaid; that the said Hospital System shall be known as the Hospital System of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar; that the term "Expenses" as herein shall mean all lawful expenses arising out of the operation, building repairs, maintenance, renewal, extension, improvement and betterment of the said Hospital System and/or the group of hospitals and/or institutions, as well as the grounds and premises connected therewith.

Section 2: That the City of San Antonio agrees to participate with the other municipalities hereinabove named and the County of Bexar in the financing of the operations of the Hospital System during the period beginning June 1, 1949 and ending May 31, 1950, by making available to the Board of Managers of said hospital system the sum of \$264,000 in monthly installments of \$22,000 each, said funds to be raised by the levy by the City of an ad valorem tax in sufficient amount for this special purpose against which prior to its collection, the City shall endeavor to borrow the funds necessary for making the monthly payments in the amount above specified; such participation by the City of San Antonio shall be conditioned upon and to continue through said twelve months' period only if the County of Bexar continues during said entire period to dedicate the full proceeds of a levy of 18.9¢ on the \$100 of assessed valuations in said County to the maintenance and support of said hospital system.

Section 3: That the County and the City shall, from and after June 1, 1950, pay and be liable for one-half of the expense of operating, conducting and managing the Hospital System as hereinabove defined, and thereafter annually at the beginning of each budget period of the County and the City, respectively, or at such other time mutually agreed upon, set aside and appropriate such sums or amounts of money as seem proper and necessary to defray and cover the expenses required to conduct, operate and maintain the said Hospital System, taking into account the recommendations of the said Board of Managers; however, it is further agreed that if for any reason the said Board of Managers shall cease to exist, the said County and the said City shall continue paying the equal parts of one-half each of all the expenses made necessary and arising in the operation, conduct and management of the said Hospital System, and it is expressly agreed that the parties to this agreement shall make the necessary provisions and appropriations therefor.

SECTION 4: That there be and there is hereby created a Board of Managers which shall supervise, manage and control the Hospital System of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar. The said Board of Managers shall be composed of seven reputable citizens of the City of San Antonio and/or the County of Bexar. The first Board shall be selected on or before the first day of August, 1949, or as soon thereafter as possible, in the following manner, to-wit:

The Commissioners' Court of Bexar County shall appoint to the Board of Managers one member for a term of office expiring at the end of two (2) years from August 1, 1949, one member for a term of office expiring four (4) years from said date, and one member for a term of office expiring six (6) years from said date. In like manner, the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio shall appoint to the Board of Managers one member for a term of office expiring two (2) years from said date, one member for a term of office expiring four (4) years from said date, and one member for a term of office expiring six (6) years from said date. Similarly, the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, acting together as an appointive body, shall appoint one member for a term of office expiring six (6) years from said date. Thereafter, at the expiration of each term of office of the members so appointed to such Board of Managers, the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio shall each respectively (or jointly as to the seventh member) make and continue to make similar appointments to such Board of Managers for a term of six (6) years each. Any vacancy occurring during the term of office of any member of the Board of Managers, whether by resignation or death, shall be filled for the unexpired portion of such term by the particular appointive body, or combination of appointive bodies, which previously appointed the member of the Board of Managers whose office on said Board was vacated either by death or resignation.

Section 5: That the said Board of Managers shall select a Chairman from among their number who shall preside over all meetings of the said Board and who shall all contracts, agreements and other instruments made by said Board on behalf of Bexar County and the City of San Antonio, That a majority of the members of the said Board of Managers shall constitute a quorum with full authority and power to act.

Section 6: That said Board of Managers shall have full and complete authority to enter into any contract connected with or incident to the establishment, erection, equipping, maintaining or operating the Hospital System of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar and, in this connection, shall have authority to disburse all funds set aside by the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio as though such action had been taken by the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and/or the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio.

Section 7: That said Board of Managers shall, once each year, prepare and present to the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio a complete financial statement of the financial status of the Hospital System, together with a statement of receipts and disbursements for the previous year prepared in accordance with standard accounting principles, and shall submit therewith a proposed budget of the anticipated financial needs of said Hospital System for the ensuing year. That on the basis of such financial statements and budget the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio shall appropriate for the use of said Board of Managers in the operation of the said Hospital System the amount of money which seems proper and necessary for that purpose.

SECTION 8 That said Board of Managers shall have the authority, in connection with the erection and equipping of the Hospital System of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar, to determine the manner of expending any funds which might be provided by the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio for such purpose, whether by issuance of bonds or other obligations or by appropriation from other funds of Bexar County or the City of San Antonio.

Section 9: That said Board of Managers shall have complete and exclusive authority to manage and control all matters affecting the Hospital System of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar, it being the expressed intention of this ordinance

to reserve to the City of San Antonio and Bexar County the right only to appoint members to such Board of Managers and the approve the annual budget hereinabove provided for.

Section 10: That the Hospital System of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar is declared to be established and operated in the performance of a governmental function, and it is directed to be so operated as such, and not otherwise.

Section 11: That this agreement shall become effective from and after the passage of this ordinance by the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, and upon the enactment by the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County, Texas, of a resolution or order agreeing to the terms and provisions of this ordinance.

Section 12: That the County of Bexar and the Commissioners' Court of said County enter into this agreement in pursuance of all general and special authority conferred under the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Texas, and the City of San Antonio and the Board of Commissioners of said City enter into this agreement in pursuance of the authority conferred by the Charter of the City of San Antonio and the general and special authority conferred by the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Texas.

Section 13: That all agreements, ordinances, orders and conveyances heretofore enacted, adopted or made with reference to the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital and the Hospital System are hereby superseded and set aside, and all ordinances in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

Section 14: The inadequacy of ordinances heretofore enacted which relate to the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital creates an urgency and an emergency requiring that, for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety, this ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so ordained.

WHEREAS, all payments have been made by the City Public Service Board (San Antonio Gas and Electric System), of the City of San Antonio, in accordance with Sections 2,3,4,5,6 and 7 of Article V, of the Ordinance and Indenture authorizing issuance of City of San Antonio Electric and Gas Revenue Bonds, passed and approved on July 25, 1942 and amended on October 23, 1942, and all obligations thereinstatisfied; and,

2. WHEREAS, there remains from the income of said San Antonio Gas and Electric System for the year 1946 the sum of \$750,000.00 over and above all such payments and obligations; NOW, THEREFORE:-

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

3. That the City Public Service Board (San Antonio Gas and Electric System) be and it is requested and directed to deposit, to the credit of the 1949 General Fund - City of San Antonio, in the National Bank of Commerce, the present depository of the City of San Antonio, said sum of \$750,000.00 surplus funds remaining from the operations of the said Gas and Electric System for the fiscal year 1946, said amount to become a part of the 1949 General Fund of the City of San Antonio and to be used for such lawful purpose or purposes as may be prescribed by the Board of Commissioners, in accordance with Section 7 of Article V of said Ordinance and Indenture above referred to and made a part hereof by reference, for all intents and purposes.

AMMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE EXPRESSING AN AGREEMENT FOR THE JOINT OPERATION OF THE ROBERT B. GREEN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AND ITS SUBSIDIARY HOSPITALS AND/OR INSTITUTIONS, BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE COUNTY OF BEXAR, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE OFFICERS WHO ARE TO MANAGE AND CONTROL THE SAME, PRESCRIBING THEIR TERMS OF OFFICE, PRESCRIBING THEIR POWERS AND DUTIES, PROVIDING FOR THE FINANCEING OF MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS, PROVIDING THAT THE OPERATION OF SAID, HOSPITAL AND ITS SUBSIDIARY HOSPITALS AND/OR INSTITUTIONS SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE A STRICTLY GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY", PASSED AND APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO ON THE 16th DAY OF JUNE, A. D. L(\$), BEING ORDINANCE NO. 9865

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That an ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE EXPRESSING AN AGREEMENT FOR THE JOINT OPERATION OF THE ROBERT B. GREEN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AND ITS SUBSIDIARY HOSPITALS

AND /OR INSTITUTIONS, BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE COUNTY OF BEXAR, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE OFFICERS WHO ARE TO MANAGE AND CONTROL THE SAME, PRESCRIBING THEIR POWERS AND DUTIES, PROVIDING FOR THE FINANCING OF MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS, PROVIDING THAT THE OPERATION OF SAID HOSPITAL AND ITS SUBSIDIARY HOSPITALS AND/OR INSTITUTIONS SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE A STRICTLY GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTION, AND DECLARING AN EMGERNCY", passed and approved by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio on the 16th day of June, A. D. 1949, being Ordinance No. 9865, be and the same is amended hereby so that the same shall hereafter read as follows:

2. "WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County, Texas, and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio have heretofore cooperated with each other in the establishment, building, equipment and maintenance of the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital, and it is deemed advisable by the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar that a new agreement be made between the aforesaid governing bodies of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar, Texas, respectively, which said agreement shall take the place of and be in lieu of any and all agreements in the premises heretofore made by and between the said political subdivisions; and,

"WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the laws of the State of Texas, and to the Charter and Ordinances of the City of San Antonio, Texas, it is deemed advisable that the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital, heretofore constructed and maintained jointly by the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar, as well as the Robert B. Green Annex and the Tuberculosis Colony situated in Bexar County, both of which are operated in connection with said Hospital, shall be under the joint control of the City of San Antonio and Bexar County, Texas, as hereinafter provided; and,

"WHEREAS, it is further deemed advisable that the joint control and management, as well as the equipment and maintenance of such hospital and its adjuncts, shall be placed under the management of a Board of Managers, as hereinafter constituted, subject to the terms and provisions of the laws of the State of Texas and the terms and provisions of this agreement; and,

WWHEREAS, an emergency exists endangering the public health by reason of inadequate funds for the more complete operation of said hospital during the ensuing year, and the officials of the municipalities of Alamo Heights, Terrell Hills and Olmos Park have indicated their desire to participate with the City of San Antonio in providing funds for the ensuing year during which it is not necessary for the City of San Antonio to participate on an equal basis with the County of Bexar in the operation and maintenance of said hospital and the institutions connected therewith, and it is, therefore, desirable to provide by this agreement for the twelve months ending May 31, 1950, on a different basis from the permanent plan for the joint operation and maintenance of said institutions:

" NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

"Section 1. That the term "County" as used herein shall mean the County of Bexar, Texas, acting by and through the Commissioners' Court of the said County, and the term "City" as used herein shall mean the City of San Antonio, Texas, acting by and through the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio; that the term "Hospital", or Hospital System" as used herein shall mean and include the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital, the Robert B. Green Annex, and the Tuberculosis Colony, together with such other hospitals and/or institutions as may become a part of the said Hospital System by mutual agreement of the City and County aforesaid; that the said Hospital System shall be known as the Hospital System of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar; that the term "Expenses" as used herein shall mean all lawful expenses arising out of the operation, building repairs, maintenance, renewal, extension improvement and betterment of the said Hospital System and/or the group of hospitals and/or institutions, as well as the grounds and premises connected therewith.

"Section 2. That the City of San Antonio agrees to participate with the other municipalities hereinabove named and the County of Bexar in the financing of the operations of the Hospital System during the period beginning June 1, 1949 and ending May 31, 1950, by making available to the Board of Managers of said hospital system the sum of \$264,00 in monthly installments of \$22,000 each, said funds to be raised by the levy by the City of an ad valorem tax in sufficient amount for this special purpose against which, prior to it's collection, the City shall endeavor to borrow the funds necessary for making the monthly payments in the amount above specified; such participation by the City of San Antonio shall be conditioned upon and to continue through said twelve months' period only if the County of Bexar continues during said entire period to dedicate the full proceeds of a levy of 18.9¢ on the \$100 of assessed valuations in said County to the maintenance and support of said hospital system.

"Section 3. That the County and the City shall, from and after June 1, 1950, each pay and be liable for one-half of the expense of operating, conducting and managing the Hospital System as hereinabove defined, and thereafter annually at the beginning of each budget period of the County and the City, respectively, or at such other time mutually agreed upon, set aside and appropriate such sums or amounts of money as seem proper and necessary to defray and cover the expenses required to conduct, operate and maintain the said Hospital System, taking into account the recommendations of the said Board of Managers; however, it is further agreed that if for any reason the said Board of Managers shall cease to exist, the said County and the said City shall continue paying the equal parts of one-half each of all the expenses made necessary and arising in the operation, conduct and management of the said Hospital System, and it is expressly agreed that the parties to this agreement shall make the necessary provisions and appropriations thereof.

"Section 4. That there be and there is hereby created a Board of Managers which shall supervise, manage and control the Hospital System of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar. The said Board of Managers shall be composed of seven reputable citizens of the City of San Antonio and/or the County of Bexar. The first Board shall be selected on or before the first day of August, 1949, or as soon thereafter as possible, in the following manner, to-wit:

"The Commissioners' Court of Bexar County shall appoint to the Board of Managers one member for a term of office expiring at the end of two (2) years from August 1, 1949, one member for a term of office expiring four (4) years from said date, and one member for a term of office expiring six (6) years from said date. In like manner, the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio shall appoint to the Board of Managers one member for a term of office expiring two (2) years from said date, one member for a term of office expiring four (4) years from said date, and one member for a term of office expiring six (6) years from said date. Similarly, the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, acting together as an appointive body, shall appoint one member for a term of office expiring six (6) years from said date. Thereafter, at the expiration of each term of office of the members so appointed to such Board of Managers, the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio shall each respectively (or jointly as to the seventh member) make and continue to make similar appointments to such Board of Managers for a term of six (6) years each. Any vacancy occurring during the term of office of any member of the Board of Managers, whether by resignation or death, shall be filled for the unexpired portion of such term by the particular appointive body, or combination of appointive bodies, which previously appointed the member of the Board of Managers whose office on said Board was vacated either by death or resignation.

"Section 5. That the said Board of Managers shall select a Chairman from among their number who shall preside over all meetings of the said Board and who shall sign all contracts, agreements and other instruments made by said Board on behalf of Bexar County and the City of San Antonio. That a majority of the members of the said Board of Managers shall constitute a quorum with full authority and power to act.

"Section 6. That said Board of Managers shall have full and complete authority to enter into any contract connected with or incident to the establishment, erection, equipping, maintaining or operating the Hospital System of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar and, in this connection, shall have authority to disburse all funds set aside by the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio as though such action had been taken by the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and/or the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio.

"Section 7. That said Board of Managers shall, once each year, prepare and present to the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio a complete financial statement of the financial status of the Hospital System, together with a statement of receipts and disbursements for the previous year prepared in accordance with standard accounting principles, and shall submit therewith a proposed budget of the anticipated financial needs of said Hospital System for the ensuing year. That on the basis of such financial statements and budget the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio shall appropriate for the use of said Board of Managers in the operation of the said Hospital System the amount of money which seems proper and necessary for that purpose.

"Section 8: That said Board of Managers shall have the authority in connection with the erection and equipping of the Hospital System of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar, to determine the manner of expending any funds which might be provided by the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County and the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio for such purpose, whether by issuance of bonds or other obligations or by appropriation from other funds of Bexar County or the City of San Antonio.

"Section 9: That said Board of Managers shall have complete and exclusive authority to manage and control all matters affecting the Hospital System of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar, it being the expressed intention of this ordinance to reserve to the City of San Antonio and Bexar County the right only to appoint members to such Board of Managers and to approve the annual budget hereinabove provided for.

"Section 10: That the Hospital System of the City of San Antonio and the County of Bexar is declared to be established and operated in the performance of a governmental function, and it is directed to be so operated as such, and not otherwise.

"Section 11: That this agreement shall become effective from and after the passage of this ordinance by the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, and upon the enactment by the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County, Texas, of a resolution or order agreeing to the terms and provisions of this ordinance.

"Section 12: That the County of Bexar and the Commissioners' Court of said County enter into this agreement in pursuance of all general and special authority conferred under the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Texas, and the City of San Antonio and the Board of Commissioners of said City enter into this agreement in pursuance of the authority conferred by the Charter of the City of San Antonio and the general and special authority conferred by the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Texas.

"Section 13: That all agreements, ordinances and orders heretofore enacted, adopted or made with reference to the Robert B. Green Hospital and the Hospital System which are in conflict herewith are hereby superseded and set aside, and all ordinances in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

"Section 14: The inadequacy of ordinances heretofore enacted with relate to the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital creates an urgency and an emergency requiring that, for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety, this ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so ordained:"

3. This ordinance being of urgent importance to the public peace, health and safety of the City of San Antonio, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a four-fifths vote of the Commissioners and signature of the Mayor, as made and provided by the Charter of the City of San Antonio.

TO USE THE CITY SANITARY SEWERS BY A CONNECTION OUTSIDE OF THE CITY LIMITS, ON THE PETITION OF H. B. ZACHRY PROP., INC.,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the petition of H. B. Zachry Prop., Inc., for a license to use the sanitary sewerage system of the City of San Antonio is granted hereby, subject to the following precedent conditions.

2. That the permit hereby granted is temporary and the City reserves the right to revoke same at any time, with or without notice.

3. The house plumbing and the connection with the City sewer shall be made and maintained at the cost and risk of the Licensee, in conformity with the ordinances of the City of San Antonio.

4. 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AN ORDINANCE 9976

ADOPTING RULES GOVERNING ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That attached "Rules Governing Electrical Installation" are hereby adopted and are hereby enacted just as though each paragraph, sentence, word and part thereof were set out haec verba herein.

2. Any person, firm or corporation that shall violate or shall fail to comply with any provision of such rules shall be fined not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense and each day of violation or failure to comply shall constitute a separate offense.

3. An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SAFE GUARDING OF LIFE AND PROPERTY BY REGULATING AND PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRICAL WIRING, DEVICES AND EQUIPMENT, PROVIDING THE MANNER AND WAY IN WHICH ELECTRICAL WORK SHALL BE DONE, THE KIND AND CLASS OF MATERIAL TO BE USED IN SUCH WORK, THE INSPECTION OF ELECTRICAL WORK, SCALE OF FEES FOR SUCH INSPECTION, CREATING THE OFFICE OF ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR, CREATING AN EXAMINING AND SUPERVISING BOARD, PROVIDING FOR THE GRANTING OF LICENSES TO INSTALL, MAINTAIN AND SELL ELECTRIC WIRING, DEVICES, AND EQUIPMENT, TO PREVENT INCOMPETENT PERSONS, FIRMS OR CORPORATIONS FROM INSTALLING, MAINTAINING AND SELLING ELECTRIC WIRING, DEVICES AND EQUIPMENT, DEFINING TERMS USED IN CONNECTION WITH THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRICAL WIRING, DEVICES AND EQUIPMENT AND PERSONS ENGAGED IN SUCH WORK, FIXING A PENALTY OF NOT LESS THAN \$10.00 NOR MORE THAN \$200.00 UPON CONVICTION OF THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR THE GIVING OF A BOND AND THE COLLECTION OF PENALTIES UNDER SAID BOND FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND REPEALING ALL FORMER ORDINANCES RELATING THERETO AND IN CONFLICT WITH SAID ORDINANCE", passed by the Commissioners on November 15, 1947 is hereby continued in full force and effect in all of its terms and provisions except wherein same may be in conflict with this ordinance, in which case the same is repealed only to the extent of the conflict.

4. This ordinance being of urgent importance to the public peace, health and safety of the City of San Antonio, the same shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by a four-fifths vote of the Commissioners.
