

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, JANUARY 30th, A. D. 1928, 10:00 A. M.

PRESNET: Honorable C. N. Chambers, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Bushick, Rubiola, Steffler, Wright.

On motion of Commissioner Steffler, duly seconded and carried, the minutes of the previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

A Communication from Grayburg Oil Company, requesting repeal of a certain Ordinance passed and approved on December 5, 1927, ordering removal of the plant of that Company.

AN ORDINANCE

REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION OF BUILDINGS ON WINBURN FIELD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That all buildings constructed on Winburn Field shall be of fireproof material, and building permits therefore shall be obtained from the City Building Inspector, before beginning the erection of such buildings.

2. All buildings not conforming to this regulation are hereby ordered off of said Field, and the owners thereof shall make such removal within sixty (60) days from this date.


