Mr. W. D. Trapp, Sr. and Mr. Morris S. Jennings addressed the Council with pleas that the City retain the U.S.O. Building in South San Antonio for recreational purposes. They were informed by the Mayor that the building would be kept, but that certain users would be obliged to pay rentals to help in liquidating the debt for its purchase.
