

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, JANUARY 23RD, A. D. 1933, 10:00 A. M.

PRESENT: Honorable C. M. Chambers, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Bushick, Rubiola, Steffler, Wright.

On motion, of Commissioner Wright duly seconded and carried, the reading of the Minutes of the meeting of January 16th, was dispensed with and ordered approved.

Communication from R. R. Jennett, Purchasing Agent recommending acceptance of the Bid of J. T. Simmons, Publisher to furnish the Tax Assessor with the names of the owners of Automobiles, Trucks and Vehicles etc., was read and held for consideration by the Commissioners of the Whole.

The request of Mr. A. L.
