

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, JANUARY 13TH, A.D. 1916, 4 P.M.

Present: Honorable Clinton G. Brown, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Garland, Lambert and Kearny. Absent, Steves.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

-----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS-----

Petition of Martin Wright for building permit was granted on motion of Commissioner Lambert, duly seconded and carried, work to be done under supervision of the Building Inspector.

Petition of Walter G. Strum, for correction of assessment, was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation, Garland.

Proposition of H. J. Wagenfehr to sell land to City for Incinerator Plant, was referred to Commissioner of Sanitation, Parks and Public Property.

In the matter of the petition of Sloan and Hagy relating to permit to conduct an undertaking establishment at 425 East Pecan Street, Commissioner Lamberts motion to grant the permit resulted in a tievote, Commissioners Kearny and Garland voting nay, and Mayor Brown and Commissioner Lambert voting aye.

MA-573 Commissioner Garland recommended that the petition of the Protestant Orphans Home for exemption from taxation be granted as to Lots 1-2-17 & 18 C.B. 2073. Adopted.

Petition of J.G. Baldwin for correction of assessment was read and referred to City Attorney for his opinion.

AN ORDINANCE.

Appropriating \$455.76 account of macadamizing and tarviating Wilson Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Four Hundred and fifty-five and 76/100 Dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of the Street Paving Fund, which shall be in addition to \$2000.00 heretofore appropriated on August 23rd, 1915, to pay the City of San Antonio's proportion for macadamizing and tarviating Wilson Street, between New Braunfels Avenue and City Limits, in accordance with the proposal of the Hon. County Judge of Bexar County, adopted August 23rd, 1915.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.

Commissioner Kearny introduced the following resolution, which was read and adopted.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, that, whenever

hereafter, any contractor shall bid upon any street paving of a class he has not heretofore laid under contract with this city, he shall be required to file with his proposal a statement naming the town or city in which he has previously constructed such pavement, if any, the approximate number of square yards laid, and the date and year when same was completed and accepted by said City or town.

ORDERING STREET IMPROVEMENTS and inviting bids for such work on WARWICK BOULEVARD, from South Hackberry Street to South Presa Street.

Commissioner Kearny introduced the following resolution which was read and adopted.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

WHEREAS, the County of bexar made a proposition for the improving with gravel of Zalzamora Street from Commerce Street to Castro Street, the said County to pay two-thirds of the total cost of the said improvement, and the said County desiring the City to pay one-third of the cost of said improvement; This is to authorize the Mayor to agree with the County to pay one-third of the total cost of graveling, and one third of the cost of tarviating, , if said street is tarviated or treated with any similar treatment to tarvia, of the cost of improving Zalzamora Street from Commerce Street to Caastro Street, provided that property owners buid curbs and gutter where required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, to save the said street from being dug up after its improvement by reason of the Water Company laying its water main, be and it is hereby ordered to put down a water main in said street, and property owners be given notice to make their connections therewith, and that said street be not improved until said main is installed and connections made.

AN ORDINANCE

Instructing City Engineering Department to construct two manholes in storm sewer on Craig Place and appropriating \$30.00 to pay for same.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the Engineering Department be, and they are hereby ihstructed to construct two manholes in the storm sewer running down the sidewalk from Craig Place and discharging into McCullough Avenue and that the sum of \$30.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1915 General Fund to pay for constructing the above work.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once

On recommendation of Commissioner Lambert the petition of the S. W. repair Co. for permit to install gasoline equipment at 605 Main Avenue; also petition of Eighteen Hotel for Electric sign at 104 South Street, were granted.



Amending Section 33 of the ordinance of November 15th, 1915, establishing regulations for electrical work.


