MONDAY, NOVEMBER 12th, A. D. 1923, 4 P. M.

PRESENT: Honorable John W. Tobin, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Bushick, Lambert, Steffler, Wright.

Dear Sir:-

In accordance with our conversation of yesterday afternoon while at the gravel pit in Roselawn Cemetery, we have the following proposition to submit to the City of San Antonio concerning the taking of gravel from said pit by the City; vis:

With the understanding that the City will do its own stripping and taking out of gravel and will confine its operations within the bounds agreed upon between us while on the ground, we will sell gravel from this pit to the City at the price of EIGHT CENTS per cubic yard. We will take the City's check on the gravel taken out making settlements each month on the basis of such checks as we do not care to go to the expense of keeping a checker there and feel that we can rely upon your check. This price to hold good for the period of eighteen months from the date of acceptance of this offer by the City. Thereafter, if it is found to be mutual advantage of both parties to continue the use of this pit, then further arrangements can be made.

We have decided after carefully considering this matter that it is not to our best interest to sell outright any rights in or to any defined portion of this land but to sell the gravel by the cubic yard.




Appropriating monies out of Various Funds to meet Pay Rolls.
