REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF  
SAN ANTONIO HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER OF THE CITY  
HALL, SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, AT 10:00 O'CLOCK, A. M.  
THURSDAY, JANUARY 20TH, 1944.

PRESENT: Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, and Steffler. Absent: Anderson. Mayor Mauermann presiding.




