

JULY 20, 1944

REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO,  
HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER OF THE CITY HALL, SAN ANTONIO,  
TEXAS, AT 10:00 O'CLOCK, A.M., ON THURSDAY, JULY 20th, 1944.

PRESENT: Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson; ABSENT: Mayor Mauermann; Commissioner Anderson, Mayor Pro-Tem, presiding.

On the motion of Commissioner Callaghan, seconded by Commissioner Steffler and carried by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson; Nay, Mauermann (absent), the minutes of the Regular Meeting of July 13th, 1944, and of the Recessed Meeting of July 19th, 1944, were approved as written.

The following two petitions were presented and referred to the City Engineer:

Assistant City Attorney Hugh Robertson addressed the Council in regard to a complaint, which had been referred to the City Attorney's Office by the City Engineer, concerning a reported encroachment on Catalina Street. He requested that the Council direct the removal of the encroachment. On the motion of Commissioner Steffler, seconded by Commissioner Callaghan and carried by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson; Nay, Mauermann (absent), the following resolution was passed:

A RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE REMOVAL OF ENCROACHMENT ON CATALINA STREET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That Mrs. M. A. Willemin and husband be and they are hereby ordered to vacate and remove all buildings and other obstructions they have placed and erected upon that portion of Catalina Street immediately north of Pomona Street, and adjacent to the San Antonio and Aransas Pass Railway right-of-way, within thirty days from the date of the delivery to them of a certified copy of this order by the Chief of Police.

2. That in the event of the failure or refusal of the said Mrs. M. A. Willemin and husband to comply with this order of the City Commissioners, the Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements shall remove such obstructions in the street aforesaid, and may file such charges as are authorized by the ordinances of the City of San Antonio as may be necessary to collect the fines and penalties as the law prescribes.

3. A copy of a plat of this site is attached to this resolution and made a part hereof by reference.




