ACCEPTING BID OF H. DICKSON, OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, TO PURCHASE
PRINTING EQUIPMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio:-

1. That the bid of H. Dickson, of 805 Vanderbilt Street, San Antonio, Texas, dated August 14th, 1941, to purchase printing equipment owned by the City of San Antonio and located in Printing Room on the third floor of the City Hall, in the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, including:
