

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, MAY 7TH, A.D.1923, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Hon. John P. Pfeiffer, Mayor Pro-tem, presiding, and Commissioners Lambert, Wright. Absent, Mayor Black and Commissioner Rieden.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING WERE ORDERED APPROVED.

Petition of residents in the vicinity of Salinas and Richter Streets protesting against the erection of a colored church.

Petition of W.O.W. for use of Market Hall July 4, 1923, was read and granted on motion of Commissioner Lambert.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation: Church of Our Lady of Perpetual Help for exemption from taxation. Mamie and Mike Trevino, for refund of taxes.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police: For arc light, Berkshire and Yorkshire Streets. Three Bros. Lunch Room, for permit to erect electric sign.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Streets, etc. J.R.Sims, for payment of salary. W.W.Carpenter, for payment of salary. Chas Franz, for payment of wages.

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$1.00 to pay Catarino Brecino.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$1.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund, Contingencies Dept. to refund cost of dog license #1371 to Catarino Brecino, the dog having been killed at City Pound.

AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing and directing the Commissioner of Taxation to accept the sum of \$1,900.00 as a compromise settlement in full of all taxes due by the Charles Davis Company to the City of San Antonio for the current fiscal year 1922.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That the Commissioner of Taxation of the City of San Antonio be and is hereby authorized and directed to accept the sum of \$1900 as a compromise settlement in full of all taxes due by the Charles Davis Company situated at 611 West Commerce Street, San Antonio, Texas, to the City of San Antonio, for the current fiscal year 1922; and he is further authorized and directed to issue proper tax receipts showing the payment of said taxes.

SECTION TWO: The City Attorney is hereby authorized and directed to dismiss at defendants costs the suit for injunction against said Charles Davis Company for the collection of said taxes, being suit No.B-33,226 now pending in the 73rd District Court of Bexar County, Texas.

AN ORDINANCE

Changing the name of Vere Street to West Agarita Avenue, said street being only one block in length and extending from the street crossing over the S.A & A.P.tracks to Warner Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That the name of Vere Street be and the same is hereby changed to

West Agarita ~~XXXXXX~~, said Vere Street being only one block in length, and extends from the street crossing over the S.A & A.P.tracks at the western end of Western end of West Agarita Avenue on Beacon Hill, to Warner Street, one block west.

SECTION TWO: The City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to make proper notation on his records of this change.
