HELD MARCH 10TH, A.D. 1917, 11 A.M.

Pursuant to order of adjournment on March 9th, A.D. 1917.

PRESENT: Honorable Clinton G. Brown, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Garland, Lambert, Kearny and Uhr.

AN ORDINANCE regulating Local Street Transportation, and to make certain alterations in the licenses and routes of motor buses, etc, was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Garland, Lambert and Uhr. Nays, Brown and Kearny.


