PRESENT: Honorable O. B. Black, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Pfeiffer, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

Petition for the opening of a jitney line to start at S. Presa Street and Eads Avenue was read and referred to the Mayor.

Petition of W.E.Long for refund of fee for plumbing permit was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

Sam Lucchese, protesting against erection of tent show at Guadalupe and San Jacinto Streets.
Rialto Theatre Co. for permit to erect electric sign.

Bids for paving Dallas Street, Cincinnati Ave, Lamar Street, Woodlawn Ave and San Pedro Ave, were opened and referred to City Engineer for tabulation.
