

AN ORDINANCE 2014 - 10 - 16 - 0 794

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION AND ACCEPTANCE OF A \$3,683,500.00 GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL TOWER AT STINSON MUNICIPAL AIRPORT; AND AUTHORIZING MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE STINSON REVOLVING FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,135,649.00.

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WHEREAS, the Aviation Department has coordinated with the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) for the design and construction of a new air traffic control tower at Stinson Municipal Airport (Stinson); and

WHEREAS, TXDOT provides 90% of all project costs up to \$2,000,000.00 and the City provides the remaining 10% of all project costs as well as all costs that exceed \$2,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2011-08-18-0666, City Council authorized TXDOT as its agent for the purpose of administrating all funds for the tower design and construction, selecting the consultants and contractors and administering the contracts necessary for the implementation of these improvements; and

WHEREAS, the grant for the design of the air traffic control was \$537,638.00 with TXDOT providing 90%, or \$483,875.00, and the City providing its 10% share of \$53,763.00 and the grant for the construction is in an amount not to exceed \$3,683,500.00; and

WHEREAS, as a result, the total project cost has exceeded \$2,000,000.00 resulting in an increase in the City's match to an amount not to exceed \$2,135,649.00 including \$200,000.00 in contingency; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Aviation Department, is hereby authorized to submit an application for and accept grant funds in an amount up to \$3,683,500.00 from the Texas Department of Transportation for the construction of a new air traffic control tower at Stinson Municipal Airport. The City will provide the 10% required match of \$2,135,649.00 as well as cover expenses not eligible for grant funds.

SECTION 2. Fund 2605833045 entitled "Stinson - Air Traffic Control Tower" and internal order 133000000095 are hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the ratification of this grant. The sum of up to \$2,000,000.00 from TXDOT and \$2,135,649.00 from the Stinson Revolving Fund will be appropriated in said fund.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.




