AN ORDINANCE *MM-804*

APPROPRIATING \$1,000.00 TO PAY THE SHARE OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO IN TEXAS RELIEF COMMISSION PROJECT 15-B-14-9 TO IMPROVE SAN PEDRO CREEK AND PARK.

AN ORDINANCE *MM-805*

AN ORDINANCE *- 806*

FIXING THE DISPUTED BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN NEW CITY BLOCK 3095 AND ORIGINAL CITY LOT 19.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the controversy between Jess Edwards and the City of San Antonio as to the proper location of the Boundary line between Lot 1, New City Block 3095, Laurel Heights Terrace, and Original City Lot 19, San Jacinto Park, be and the same is hereby adjusted by an agreement fixing the boundary line between the property of the City of San Antonio and the property of Jess Edwards as follows:-

2. Beginning at a point on the east line of Kings Court, said point being 36.67 feet in a southeastern direction along the east line of Kings Court, from the intersection of the east line of Kings Court, with the north line of O.C.L.
