

JUNE 29, 1945

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER OF THE CITY HALL, AT ELEVEN O'CLOCK, A. M., ON FRIDAY, JUNE 29th, 1945.

PRESENT: Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler; ABSENT: Anderson; Mayor Mauermann presiding.

The Clerk read the call, as follows:

June 29, 1945.

To the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio:-

Gentlemen:

By virtue of the authority vested in me by the Charter of the City of San Antonio, I hereby call you in Special Session to be held at 11:00 o'clock, A. M., on Friday, June 29, 1945, to consider and act upon the following:

"A MOTION TO REJECT ALL BIDS FOR FIXTURES AND WIRING IN TAXATION DEPARTMENT".

Commissioner Hein introduced the following ordinance, which, after explanation by the City Attorney and discussion by the Council, was passed and approved by roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler; Nay, Anderson (absent).

ACCEPTING PROPOSAL OF GEORGE EVERS FOR CONCESSIONS AND PRIVILEGES IN CITY PARKS, AND MAKING CONTRACT.

A MOTION

TO REJECT ALL BIDS FOR FIXTURES AND WIRING IN TAXATION DEPT.

On motion of Commissioner Callaghan, seconded by Commissioner Steffler and carried by roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler; Nay, Anderson (absent), the Council rejected all bids to furnish and install electric fixtures, all wiring, switches and accessories, not including lamps, in the Taxation Department and directed the City Clerk to return all bidders' checks.

On motion of Commissioner Hein, seconded by Commissioner Callaghan and carried by roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler; Nay, Anderson (absent), the meeting adjourned Friday, June 29, 1945.
